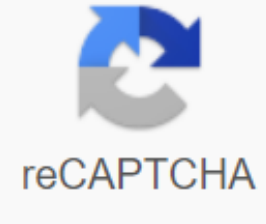




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Virtual ID (VID) is a random 16-digit number temporarily assigned to your Aadhaar number to facilitate authentication or e-KYC. This allows you to perform the necessary functions without revealing the actual Aadhaar number. You can create a VID on the Aadhaar portal. Step 2: Complete the Captcha test. Step 3: Click on the Send OTP button. Step 4: Enter the OTP you received in the proposed field and click on the Login button. Step 5: The next page will give you two options for updating the address: a) Address updates through Proof address. b) Update the address via secret code (this is if you already have a check email address). Step 6: If you choose 'Update Address via Address Proof', the next screen will show current address, and then the ability to enter a new address. Step 7: Enter all relevant information about your new address and and Preview. Step 8: You can either edit the information or send it after ticking on a consent statement. Step 9: You must download the original scanned copy of the Valid Evidence Address. Once the request is submitted, you will receive an update request number (URN). You can track the status of your address change/correction request online on the Aadhaar portal using this number. Here are the steps you should take when submitting an Aadhar card correction form at the Enrollment/Update Center. Step 1: Go to the nearest Aadhaar registration center or upgrade center, from where you can get the appropriate form and fill it out. Step 2: Download the form, fill it out, and then go to the Enrollment/Update Center. Step 3: Make sure you take off will take with the 500 necessary documents needed to verify any fixes/changes that you request. Step 4: At the Enrollment Center, you can send the form to the operator. Step 5: The operator will check the information. Once the form is submitted, you can check the status of your change request on the UIDAI self-service portal. Let's say you signed up for Aadhaar and it was delivered to your home. But you will find that there is a typo in your email ID or name. This means that you will have to make adjustments to the database. You can correct or correct a bug in your Aadhaar database using the Aadhaar Enrolment/Correction form. You don't have to pay money for fixes if they are made within 96 hours (4 days) after enrollment. Standard fees applicable to Aadhaar updates, i.e. up to Rs.50 including taxes, will be levied for fixes or updates made after this 4-day window. If you move home in the future, you can change the address in the Aadhaar database using . Previously, you could update the address by mail by filling out the Aadhaar Update Address/Correction Form, but this option is no longer highlighted by UIDAI. Instructions for filling out the Aadhaar Aadhaar Aadhaar Enrolment/Correction Form correction form are available at registration or renewal centers, as well as in the form of a PDF on the UIDAI website. Name This should contain a full full as you are legally known, but without any names or greetings such as Mrs., Mr., Or Dr. You need to substantiate your name with valid proof of identity such as passport, PAN card, driver's license, etc. UIDAI also gives a detailed list of documents that you can use as evidence on Aadhaar enrollment, correction or update. You can make minor changes to the spelling of your name without changing the name. For example, if your name is written as Rithika and you want to do the spelling of Ritika, you can do so without providing additional evidence. 2. Gender choice, which gender you belong to - male, female, or transgender. 3. Age OR Date of Birth (DoB) The date of birth should be entered in the format of DDMMYYYY: so if you were born on August 26, 1959, the record will be 26 08 1959. If you or an elderly family member is not aware of the exact DoB, you can enter the estimated age in years (not months). If you have documentary proof of the date of birth, tick against Verified, and if you don't have any evidence of the date of birth, tick against the announced. 4. Address Write your address in full, and be sure to hold the original proof address to the registration center for verification. The address is very important because the card will be sent here. If you make a mistake in the address, you will not get the Aadhaar card. You can choose C/O (care), D/O (daughter), S/O (son), W/O (wife), or H/O (husband) if you want to include the name of the parent, guardian or spouse, along with your address. Just like in the name box, you can make minor changes as long as the main address is the same as the proof you provide. This section also includes your mobile phone number and email address. The number and email ID you provide here will be your registered number and registered email ID 5. Relationship If the applicant Aadhaar is a child under 5 years of age, then the name and number of Aadhaar father, mother or guardian, must be forcibly provided in the form. However, this section is not mandatory for adults. 6. Documents Mention documents that you will present as POI (Proof of Personality), POA (Proof of Address), DOB (Date of Birth), and POR (Relationship Proof). 7. Use Introducer/HoF If you do not have any identity documents and/or address and you use a check based on the head of the family (HoF) or Introducer, then you must provide the number Aadhaar or EID HoF or Introducer. Do's and Don'ts When filling out the Aadhar update form Now that you know how to fill out a correction form for Aadhaar and how to submit a form, here are some quick notes on what to do and what not to do when or presenting the form of Aadhaar correction. Use only capital letters when filling out the form. When applying for a fix, fill only the field or field that needs to be corrected. Make sure the Aadhar update form is filled only with current and current data, not old or invalid information. Make sure the full address is full, because that's where the updated Aadhaar email will be sent. The input of the data in the local language in which Aadhaar was originally issued is no longer mandatory. Full names should not have greetings such as Mr/Dr/Colonel etc etc. make sure you attach the correct supporting document to the change. For example, if you want to change an address, sending PoA should not contain an old or invalid address. If you do not have original documents to verify, copies certified by a newspaper employee or a state notary are acceptable. It is a must to have your mobile phone number connected to/registered with Aadhaar to make a request for a fix online. The Aadhaar Card, or Unique Identification Card (UID), is one of the key identity documents and proof of address accepted by banks to open accounts, loans or deposits. It is also an important document in accordance with the rules of the banks Know Your Customer (KYC). The Aadhaar card is also required to receive benefits under government schemes such as the LPG subsidy. Applying for an Aadhaar card The first thing you need to do to apply for an Aadhaar card is to complete the questionnaire. The Aadhaar Enrollment/Correction Form is available online on the Website of the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI). You can also get a enrollment form at the local Aadhaar centre. You must submit the enrollment form along with the necessary documents - proof of identity, address documentation, proof of residence and date of birth - to the Aadhaar Center. Aadhaar enrollment form Aadhaar questionnaire presents a 2-page document, with one page containing spaces to fill out your data, and a second page containing instructions that will follow when filling out the form. The form has 11 fields that must be filled before the submission, although all of them are optional. The same form is valid for both the new Aadhaar app and the Aadhaar update or fix details. When applying for changes to the existing Aadhaar card, you must fill out Aadhaar's 12-digit number part of the form where space is provided. For the rest of the document, you only need to fill in the information that needs to be corrected. Things to remember before you start filling out the Aadhaar enrollment form, there are a few things to note to ensure provide your form is valid. Only letters of capital: The Aadhaar enrollment form must be filled in the form of capital letters, or the upper register of the letter only. Capital letters are offered because they are larger, easier to recognize, and less prone to stylistic differences. This will reduce the number of errors made by Aadhaar center employees when logging into the system. Write legibly: Don't create an inky mess on enrollment form. If your written information is not read to the official at the Aadhaar Center, there may be errors on your card. You will then have to go through the correction application process and postpone the entire process of purchasing a valid Aadhaar card. The fields on the Aadhaar enrollment form form contains 11 fields followed by the applicant's signature. However, it is not mandatory to fill all fields. Here's a summary that should be provided in these areas: NPR Receipt/TIN Number: If you have a National Population Register (NPR) Sliding Survey or Tax Identification Number (TIN), you can provide it in this column. This, again, is optional. Full name: Provide your full name, including name, sedation name (if any) and surname or surname. This should be in line with your identity document. Paul: You can identify yourself as male, female or transgender on uniform. Age or date of birth: If you are unsure of your date of birth, you can find out your approximate age in years. If you know your date of birth (DOB), know what DDMMYYYY (date-month-year) format is in the column. If you don't have any proof of documentation to verify your DOB, tick the 'Announced' box in the fifth box. If you have supporting documentation for the DOB, select the Verified box. Address: Give your full address as to indicate your proof address document. This will be the address at which the Aadhaar card will be delivered after the ready. There are separate columns to determine house No., road name, landmark, square, city or post office, etc. You can give a name for care (c/o), daughter (d/o), son (s/o), wife (w/o) or husband (h/o). In the address segment, you also have to fill out your cell phone number and email ID. They will become your registered mobile phone number and email ID, and all messages about your Aadhaar card will be made through them. Details of family members: You can find out the name and numbers of your father, mother, guardian, husband or wife. It is not mandatory for adults, but children under the age of 5 must give detailed information about their parents or guardians on their form. you get an Aadhaar card through an introduction or head of family (in case you don't have any valid proof of identity or fill their Aadhaar room here. Consent: In this part of the form, you may authorize or deny UIDAI the right to share the information you provide in the form with the agencies involved in the provision of public and social services. Choose a tick if you agree to information sharing, and select the x sign if you disagree with UIDAI by sharing your information with other government agencies. Bank account: This is an optional field. You can open a new bank or post account associated with Aadhaar, or link your existing bank account details to the Aadhaar number created. Keep in mind that no fixes can be made to this data after you've created the Aadhaar map, so fill it out carefully. Provided documents: At this point, you must choose whether the verification of your data will be based on documents provided by you, the introduction, or the head of the family. Check out the right choice. In the column For documents based be sure to mention POI (proof of personality) and POA (proof of address). You must fill out documents that you will submit to support your identity and address. A DOB document is required if you choose 'Verified' in the DOB field. A POR document (relationship proof) is only required if you use an introduction or a family head to register for an Aadhaar card. Introduction/Head of Family: If you do not have identity documents or address, you can use the introduction credentials or the head of the family (HoF) to register with Aadhaar. Signature: Sign a document with a signature, name or fingerprint to check the form. Checking the documents required for the Aadhaar card to purchase an Aadhaar card is not enough to fill out an enrollment form alone. You must provide supporting documents as an identity card, address document and date of birth. If you use an introduction or HoF to enroll in Aadhaar, a proof of relationship document should also be submitted. Once your Aadhaar enrollment form is complete, visit the nearest Aadhaar center to submit it along with the supporting documents. Center staff will take your biometric data, such as fingerprints, and click photos to add to the Aadhaar map database. You will receive a receipt with the date and time of enrollment, photography and other details. It is important to keep this recognition slipping as you need to check your Aadhaar app status online.
