In the second turn left onto South Main Street. The Noah Webster House is less than a mile from South Main Street on the right side of the street. When you exit after your program, you will be able to drive directly forward to another I-84 input. Parking School buses must park on the street in front of the museum between signs that say Authorized parking only (on the other side of the entrance). Buses Buses do not park in the parking lot under any circumstances. Cars can be parked in the museum's small parking lot. If it is full, you can park on the street in front of the house (it is marked as Authorized for our use).
