However, the Great Turk was not happy with the Treaty of Mihalopol. This might be attributed to the following reasons: First, the peace treaty was concluded at the expense of the Romanian army. Second, there was a lack of consensus on its terms. Third, the treaty was not favourable to the Ottomans, because they were not able to take Târgoviște. Fourth, the treaty had been negotiated by General Uglük, who was not in favour of the Ottomans. In other words, he had only been paying attention to the interests of the Danubian Principalities. In this case, it would have been necessary for him to follow his own interests. This matter has not been clarified. The reasons for which the Great Turk was not satisfied with the Treaty of Mihalopol might have had another meaning: the Great Turk had not been forced to conclude a peace treaty and had therefore concluded it freely. In this context, it is more probable that he had not wanted to ratify the peace treaty concluded by General Uglük. In conclusion, we do not know whether the Great Turk was pleased with the Treaty of Mihalopol, but one thing is certain: the Great Turk did not ratify the Treaty of Mihalopol. This means that he would have not been pleased with the Treaty of Roman. This matter should be considered further by historians of the Bulgarian and Romanian School.¹³ The next period that came to pass after the signing of the Treaty of Mihalopol was the failure to ratify the peace treaty signed by General Uglük in 1193.¹⁴ This is the matter that concerns the Bulgarian Historians. In view of this, it is worth mentioning that the Danubian Principalities' peace treaty was concluded with the Great Turk not to give in but because the countries' forces were now weak. In the situation that arose after the Treaty of Mihalopol, the rulers of the principalities could not give in. The treaty was concluded with the help of a foreign state. It was a sign of their weakness. In this case, it would have been better to continue their 520fdb1ae7
