How God Answers Prayer


3 Ways:

1. Yes - Centurion's Servant

Matthew 8:13 Jesus said to the centurion, "Go your way. Let it be done for you as you have believed." His servant was healed in that hour.

2. No – Paul's Thorn in the Flesh

2 Corinthians 12:8-9 Concerning this thing, I begged the Lord three times that it might depart from me. He has said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Most gladly therefore I will rather glory in my weaknesses, that the power of Christ may rest on me.

3 Ways:


3. Wait - Lazarus' illness




Baby Steps


Summary

Therefore, put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and, having done all, to stand.


