We welcome you joining us for the ikebana practicing at La Jolla Library. Regarding your questions, here is the information.

- Any students can sign up class through the San Diego Sakura Chapter's Email at: ikebana.sakura.lj@gmail.com It is required at least three days in advance to complete the registration otherwise the floral materials will not be guaranteed.
- Any students can sign up for one lesson or two lessons or a series which includes three consecutive lessons. The fresh cut flower materials are provided by the teacher. To cover the cost of fresh cut flower materials provided by the teacher, the students should pay \$60.00 for a series which includes three consecutive lessons on Saturdays or \$25.00 for a single lesson, \$45.00 for two lessons in a series. **To new students, prepay is encouraged to ensure we have enough materials.** Cash or Zelle OK no credit cards.
- The class time is: Class A (9:15 - 11:30am) for advanced students; Class B (11:30am – 2:30pm) for intermediate and beginner students.
- The students need to bring their own ikebana tools such as, containers, kenzans, floral scissors, etc. For new students, we can lend them appropriate tools for their first-time practicing in the class. We also provide new or used ikebana basic tools for our students in affordable price.
- All of the students will receive an E-mail about ten days prior to the new series which includes class information and reminder of registration to the class. Students can sign up or cancel their attendance before the dead line without any charge.
