About the idea

"Museum with home delivery" is a solution based on the idea of social meetings of animators with the elderly and the creation of local, neighbourhood "museums of memories". The museum would be based on memories, personal items and souvenirs – photos, documents, letters, postcards, clothes, furniture.

In the idea of "Museum with home delivery" it is crucial to create a network of animators who are ready to visit elderly people, who survived Nazi persecution, and build their own home museums with them. The museum collections, developed in the form of a film, radio play or exhibition, would then be arranged by the given animators in the public space, so that as many residents as possible could learn about the history of the senior's life. The exhibition could be accompanied by open meetings and other neighbourhood activities.

Benefits of the idea

Thanks to the involvement in the creation of the home museum, seniors will gain new acquaintances and will be included in the life of the local community. Conversations with an animator and working on the harvest will also help to improve concentration and memory, and will also make seniors feel appreciated and important to others.

Older persons would love to talk about the past, but there are not always people who have the time or the willingness to listen to them. My goal is to respond to their need to be heard and appreciated
