

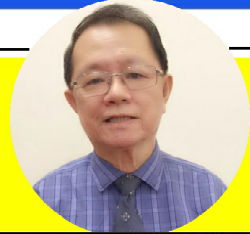

a. Faith in Jesus Christ - believing that He loved me and died for me as the promised Son of God. *John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish, but have eternal life.*

b. Repentance from past sins - changing my life from serving sin to God. *Acts 3:19 Repent therefore, and turn again, that your sins may be blotted out, so that there may come times of refreshing from the presence of the Lord,*


c. Confession of my faith - declaring my conviction to pursue this new direction. *Romans 10:9 If you will confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus, and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.*

d. Baptism into the death of Christ - the washing away of my sins and walking in a new life. Romans 6:3-4 *Or don't you know that all we who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were buried therefore with him through baptism to death, that just like Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we also might walk in newness of life.*

Bible example of first Christians Acts 2:37-41 - *"Brothers, what shall we do?" With many other words he testified, and exhorted them, saying, "Save yourselves from this crooked generation!" Then those who gladly received his word were baptized. c. You are added to Christ's church - Acts 2:41 *Then those who gladly received his word were baptized. There were added that day about three thousand souls.*

d. You now have a home in heaven - John 14:2-3 *In my Father's house are many mansions... I am going to prepare a place for you.*

What is the Gospel?

The word gospel is derived from the term **god-spell**, meaning "good news" or "good telling."

1 Peter 3:15 *But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts; and always be ready to give an answer to everyone who asks you a reason concerning the hope that is in you, with humility and fear*

in a Nutshell

WHAT IS

the Gospel?



1. Start at the Beginning

Genesis 1:1 *"In the beginning, God..."* - The first four words of the Bible reveals that God existed right at the beginning.

Genesis 1:18 *"God created the heaven and the earth."* - God was not aloof nor inactive.


He created both heaven and earth.

Genesis 1:27 *"So God created man in His own image."* - Of all the things God has created, only mankind was created to be like Him.

Genesis 6:5 *"And God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth."* - Although mankind received every good thing from God, he strayed and became full of wickedness.

WHAT IS

the Gospel?



2. Payment for Sin

John 3:16 *"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten son..."* - To help us return to God, God became flesh in the person of Jesus and showed us the right way to live.

John 1:11 *"He came unto His own, and His own received Him not."* - Instead of accepting Jesus, the world spurned Him and eventually got rid of Him by nailing Him on a cross.

1 Corinthians 15:3 *"Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures."* - In dying on the cross, Jesus took the penalty for our wickedness and redeemed us from our sin.

1 Corinthians 15:4 *"And that He was buried, and arose again the third day."* - Jesus. He proved all He had said and promised by rising from the dead.

WHAT IS
the Gospel?

3. Gift of the Holy Spirit

Acts 1:8 "Ye shall receive power when the Holy Spirit is come upon you..." - After Jesus died, was buried and resurrected from the dead, He promised to send His followers the Holy Spirit.

Acts 2:38 "Repent ye, and be baptized...and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." - Mankind can receive the abiding presence of the Holy Spirit when he turns from his wickedness and is baptized.

Romans 8:13 "For if we live after the flesh, ye shall die." - To continue to live without God, we bring pain and sorrow to our lives while we live, and then die without any hope.

WHAT IS
the Gospel?

4. Return of Jesus Christ

Romans 8:14 "For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God." - However, we can change our lives by following what the Holy Spirit would have us do to become children of God.

Revelation 22:17 "And the Spirit and the bride say, come." - The Holy Spirit together with Jesus and the bride invite you to turn from your present lifestyle and come to God.

"And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely." -The choice is yours to make. The rewards are great, but no one can force you to make this change.

Revelation 3:20 "Behold, I stand at the door and knock; if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him." - Jesus is knocking at the door of your heart even as you read this. Will you open your door to Him while there is still time?

Revelation 22:20 "He who testifies these things says, 'Yes, I come quickly.' Amen! Yes, come, Lord Jesus" – Time is limited

The good news is that it is not too late now.

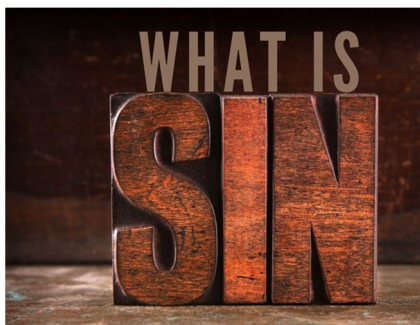



When we have decided to deal with the sin in our life, let us get back into the Christian race by making it our goal not to sin



It is hard to believe that in 6 weeks, we will be celebrating our 6th anniversary. Here is a brief summary of our short history...

First year: We started the only evening service among the churches of Christ at the Salvation Army at Hillview next to the MRT. We had good support from members of many congregations including Filipinos, Indians and SIBI students.

Second year: With new members from the east, we moved to the more centrally located Metropolitan YMCA next to the Stevens MRT. The congregation had an average attendance of over 30 with many visiting members from overseas attending.



As a mission-minded congregation, we hosted our first Missions Retreat with participants from Malaysia, Indonesia and China pictured above.

Third year: We best remember 2019 as the year when the Covid-19 pandemic hit

us. It was no longer business as usual. As an unregistered church, we were no longer allowed to rent the Y and had to meet at my office at the Pasir Panjang Church of Christ, live streaming each Sunday.

Fourth year: As rules regarding the pandemic eased, we returned to in-person worship. Although we have lost a family and a member during the uncertain period of the pandemic, God has blessed us with many more new members.

Fifth year: As we needed a larger place for proper worship and fellowship, the Household of Faith was officially registered. Attendance has picked up and now all activities have resumed.

God blessed us with 4 new members and we are looking forward to reaching out to our families and friends with the gospel. Through thick and thin, the Lord has watched over us, our members have stayed together, and God has given us the increase.

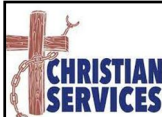
Not everyone can serve the Lord full-time, but like Aquila and Priscilla, we can be tentmakers.

2 Timothy 4:2 *Preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, and exhort, with complete patience and teaching.*
