Ideological attractiveness is based on a very sentimental theme of the nation and the Hindu race, and it constantly imposes on its listeners/readers that there is a constant threat from other races or countries to our existence, and therefore we must always be ready/trained in war. The views on minorities are very provocative. It is expected that minorities will constantly prove and be ready to study their love for the Motherland. There is an assumption about power for yourself as a conscious custodian of society and to prescribe how people in general should behave to protect/develop our culture. Few basic excerpts and ideas from this book are as follows - Golwalkar first segregated Indian society by uniting all non-Muslim and non-Christian as Hindu regardless of their cast, creed, etc. But he doesn't name Jain Acharya, who said so. He suggested that his consideration of all sects as Hindu was and perhaps should be acceptable to all. Similar free links exist throughout the book where Golwalkar has not given exact names, place or publications where his claims can be verified. One such allegation is Gandija quoting Hindus in one of the riots in Gujrat to kill or kill instead of running away - no attempt is made to give any verification of his quote. He is constantly calling for the need to be prepared and strong enough to protect our land and race from enemies. In Part 2 of Chapter 1, internal threats are defined as 1. Muslims2. Christians3. The Communists of Goluokkar in this book mentions that every Hindu is a born Hindu from the womb of his mother before his birth, while others are born as a person and then circumcised or baptized to become either Muslims or Christians. There is absolutely nothing in it that could be called our own. As long as Christians here indulge in such activities and consider themselves agents of the international movement for the spread of Christianity, and refuse to order their first allegiance to the land of their birth and behave like true children of the heritage and culture of their ancestors, they will remain here as hostile and should be treated as such. In these circumstances, only an organization such as Sang is called upon to transform our people into a clean, holy, benevolent and organized life, breathing the spirit of sacrifice and heroism, and based on the positive and unchanging foundation of our ancient and glorious statehood, which can be relied upon to protect and rejuvenate our nation. And it is the call of this still unfulfilled mission that drives Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh's ever-increasing and ever-expanding work.
