

About the Trail

Overview

This trek visits three villages nearby Pindaya and through scenic surroundings with tea plantations and forested areas. It starts with a climb, heading towards the highest point of the city and gradually descends into Pindaya. This route gives great views of Pindaya and surrounding area. It is possible to arrange a lunch stop in one of the villages (your guide will need to do this for you ahead of time).

The trail is in good condition, and often used by people in the villages who are traveling to Pindaya. It could be used for mountain biking.

This trail is mainly a scenic, natural and cultural trail, that passes through several villages. In the village of Sikya Inn, between Htwet Ni and Taung Baw Gyi is a tea factory where tourists can stop to take a look at the tea making process.

In Taung Baw Gyi Village, there are four to five houses that welcome tourists for lunch, if arranged ahead of time. Houses were built around 2005. Stopping in the villages gives a chance to experience traditional village life, including farming practices and traditional food preparation such as picked tea, Indian leaks etc.
