

Richard J. "Rick" Gilfillan, M.D. is an independent consultant and volunteer working with nonprofit organizations seeking to create accountable high value healthcare. For more than 30 years, he has built successful organizations in the for-profit and not-for-profit sectors to deliver better outcomes for people and communities. Previously, he was President and CEO of Trinity Health, a \$19 billion Catholic health system that serves communities in 22 states from 2013 to 2019. Dr. Gilfillan was the first director of the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Innovation (CMMI); he

launched the Center in 2010, and till 2013, worked with payers and providers to develop innovative models for improving patient care and reducing costs.

Prior to his appointment at CMMI, Dr. Gilfillan was President and CEO of Geisinger Health Plan and Executive Vice President of Insurance Operations for Geisinger Health System, a large integrated health system in Pennsylvania. Previously, he was the senior vice president for national network management at Coventry Health Care. He has also served as Senior Vice President for National Network Management at Coventry Health Care, and as Chief Medical Officer for Independence Blue Cross. Dr. Gilfillan earned his undergraduate and medical degrees from Georgetown University, and an MBA degree from the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania.
