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The Practicalities

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION

- Holding a Level 3 Award in Food Safety is highly recommended.
- The course requires at least 60 hours, of which 40 are guided/structured (which includes the classroom sessions).
- A laptop or PC with basic office programmes, and an ability to use shared Cloud-based storage, and online collaborative tools.
- Assessment is through a 2.5 hour examination.
- Exam Part 1 comprises a 30 question multi-choice questions, worth 30 marks. Part 2 is a written section, where delegates choose 4 from 6 questions. This section is worth 70 marks.
- Pass is 50 marks across both parts, Merit is 60 and Distinction 70.
- The course is regulated by Highfield Awarding Body for Compliance.
