But sometimes it's not enough to just be a smart official: you have to know how to communicate well. The Chinese elite use a messaging app that they developed themselves to form "WeChat groups" that build clout and status among their members, who use the software's features to network and stay in touch. The app, WeChat, has 300 million registered users and is one of the most popular messaging apps in China, according to the latest numbers from app analytics firm App Annie. Groups have become a ubiquitous way to organize social interactions, whether you're on WeChat, in a college dorm, or in a professional setting. And because the app is so embedded in the country's fabric, it's something that's being used to organize protests against the government. In late April, President Xi Jinping of China announced that a nationwide social credit system would be used to prevent "mass incidents" like last month's protests, in which nearly 200 people died. Soon after, WeChat launched a function that allowed users to invite other users to their own "mass incident-prevention system" groups. WeChat groups don't work exactly like those in other messaging apps. For instance, Facebook and WhatsApp's groups are public and anyone can join. But because WeChat groups are meant to be private, they require a private group invitation. That way, only those who are part of the group can see the group members. The groups function like the modern analogue of the old "closed community" groups that were used for organizing back when the internet was new. That's because it was once common in China for people to only interact with people they knew in real life. However, this barrier to communication isn't entirely secure. When researcher Mary Anastasia O'Grady, who's focused on digital policing, looked at the privacy policies of the relevant groups, she found that it was easy to circumvent. After gaining access, she was able to see who had been invited to each group, and there's not much that the app's administrators can do to prevent it. The WeChat 520fdb1ae7
