

OVERVIEW

Dive into cross-cultural mission in Aotearoa New Zealand. Experience Māori culture, serve in local cross-cultural ministries, and grow spiritually as you live out the gospel in a land being restored.

Your 3 weeks in Aotearoa will include cultural exchange, prayer walking, ministry work, youth work, evangelism

Week 1

Arrival and Mihi Whakatau (Māori welcome ceremony)

Noho Marae Experience

- Live at a marae and learn Māori customs and values
- Team building, worship, and devotions
- Hear from Māori Christian leaders



Week 2: Ministry

Cross-Cultural Ministry experiences

- Youth ministry: events, mentoring, school visits
- Migrant & refugee outreach: ESL, meals, support
- Join local church services and home groups
- Community projects and outreach
- Farm experience: gardening, animals, rural life



Week 3: Travel & ministry

- Travel to Wellington via Rotorua, Taupō, and other towns
- Serve with local churches and cross-cultural ministries
- Youth nights, street ministry, refugee support
- Workshops: Holy Spirit & Evangelism
- Spiritual mentoring and team building
- Explore Wellington (fishing if weather allows)



Final 3 days: Wrap up

- Return to Hamilton
- Group debrief and one-on-one check-ins
- Share testimonies and lessons learned
- Farewell celebration and prep for return



Estimated Costs

- Transport: NZD \$300
- Food: NZD \$450 (approx. \$15/day)
- Accommodation: NZD \$540 (WEC rate)
- Total: NZD \$1,500 ≈ USD \$1,000
- Excludes flights, insurance, visa fees

- Willingness to engage with different cultures
- Participation in all scheduled activities
- Respect for other traditions & customs
- Open heart for growth, teamwork, and spiritual formation
