Grammar Refresher - September 11

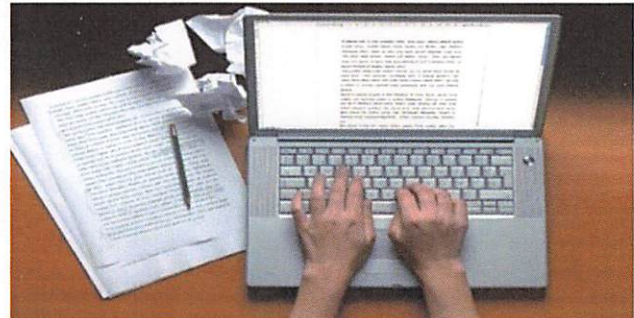
Learn practical and easy-to-remember rules for sentence fragments and run-ons, subject-verb agreement, proper use of commas, colons and semicolons.
