Fire wardens/stewards at a ratio of 1:50 in agreed positions.</p> <p>Lead fire person briefs all stewards before the event as well as doing pre-checks.</p> <p>The meeting point in the event of an evacuation is the Little Green (opposite the Richmond Theatre)</p>			✓
