### Getting a Replacement Birth Certificate

Call (517) 335-8656 to request an application for a birth certificate. Along with the signed application, an individual must send a photocopy of current photo identification (state driver's license, state personal ID card, or passport), and a fee (\$34, or \$14 for persons over 65 years).

### Getting a Replacement Social Security Card

To obtain a replacement card, you must use original documents or agency-certified copies to:

1. Prove citizenship using a birth certificate or US passport
2. Prove identify using a US driver's license, state issued non-driver identification card, or US passport. In the case that you cannot provide these documents or cannot obtain a replacement within 10 days, you may be permitted to submit additional current documents that include your name, date of birth or age, and preferably a photograph. These additional documents include:
  - a. Employee identification card,
  - b. School identification card,
  - c. Health insurance card (not a Medicare card), or
  - d. US military identification card
