When I make a new.docx file in Microsoft Office 2016 Pro Plus VL X64 MULTI-22 SEP 2018 (Gen2) and save it, it auto saves as a.docx with the following name: 937656.docx. This is a problem for me because it messes up my filename. Does anyone know how I can change it to the following instead? 937656.docx A: I am sorry, but the options that you mention (including date format) don't exist for the format DOCX in this version of Microsoft Office 2016 Pro Plus. The way I have to handle this situation is to save it in another format, e.g. OLE format. This is how I would do it: Create a new empty folder on your computer, e.g. save the file .saveAs("C:\test.docx") In this folder, create a new file with the extension.docx. I would just call it test.docx, or change it to whatever you wish. Open the new file and copy paste the file from your previous file. Now open the original file, go to File > Properties and choose "Save As" and save it in OLE format. This will preserve the original filename.
