Conditions of Entry

Artists may enter up to four original artworks in each category. **Items that have previously been displayed at the WPA Iron Festival will not be accepted.**

Artworks (including frame) must not exceed 100cm by 100cm.
The Iron/Metal Sculpture must weigh less than 20kg.

All works in the open art must have one pair of D-rings/triangle rings attached, approximately 1/3 down from the top. Cord should be picture hanging quality, wire should be braided type picture hanging quality. Please ensure they can support the weight of your work. All works must be dry.
Works may be refused if they do not meet these requirements.

Works should be clearly marked with your name, title, and the selling price if applicable.

A 25% commission will be charged on all works sold during the exhibition. Proceeds will assist the Wundowie Progress Association hold future events and activities within the Community.

The Committee reserves the right to use discretion when determining which items will be accepted and how they will be displayed. This includes works which could present a safety risk to the viewing public.

Closing Date for Entries – 11th September 2023

Work may be dropped off at the Wundowie Hall on **Thursday 14th September between 3—4pm**, or on **Friday 15th September between 9am and 10am**.

Pick up work – 16th September 2023

All work will be available for collection on **16th September** from the Wundowie Hall **between 3.00 – 4.00pm**.

No responsibility will be taken for uncollected items. The Committee reserves the right to donate any uncollected items to a worthy cause.

Organiser's Liability:

Whilst every care will be taken, the Committee accepts no liability for damage to items. Exhibitors are advised to insure their own items.
