You will no doubt remember that we have already launched an article about the simplest PS4 Platinum Trophies to strengthen your collection with minimal effort, but what about the other end of the spectrum? What are the hardest or laborious platinum you can pop to really show off to your friends? These are the most difficult platinum PS4 trophies available right now. Not including games that are broken or require online play, but no one plays them, Crypt of Necrodancer is perhaps closer to the impossible Platinum Trophy ever created by mortal hands. As it stands, Trophy-tracking web psnprofiles.com lists just 11 users as having a bonked platinum gong on this one, with a trophy rarity of 0.06%. So, what makes this trophy list PlayStation 4 own Mount Everest? Well, it's notoriously hard to rhythm-based roguelike to start with, but in order to unlock all the trophies, you need to play the game about fifty times, including a few runs with each character with increasingly silly limitations. The coup de grace is the trophy's lowest of the lows, which challenges you with beating the game with all nine characters, back-to-back in one run, not dying at all and with every character still in their gear by default. Anyone who watches platinum in the crypt of Necrodancer should get a personal visit from Shuhei Yoshida himself to present them with an actual Platinum Trophy donning a mantle next to an image of their mom. Final Fantasy IX Platinum is pretty easy, if a little grinding, aside from one absurd trophy. Hello, King will unlock only after you have participated in Final Fantasy IX skipping the mini-game and jumped the rope 1000 times or more without stumbling. Getting to 1000 successful jumps will take a solid eight minutes buttons at the perfect time, but the timing of the jumps periodically changes as you you and that's before you even consider the input lag between the controller and the TV. Going to Hello, The King is so pad-snappingly annoying that treacherous Trophy hunters have come up with a workaround that involves starting a remote playback session on your PC and running a specially created script that takes care of skipping for you automatically. Sure, it's crappy, but getting a trophy is the main thing, isn't it? The answer, of course, is no. How dare you. You can file this under laborious rather than really hard as you would probably expect from MMORPG. The trophy that you really have to watch out for in this is an adventurer's life that will unlock once you have completed 1000 levequests. Leve quests are not difficult, but you can only start one by spending a special currency called levequest allowance. You automatically get three surcharges every 12 real hours, but you can only keep 100 of them at any given time, so you can't just save them all and blow through that trophy at a time. If you make your three levequests every day, then you're looking at a six-month commitment, and by the time you throw in all the other trophies, it's probably going to take almost 1,000 hours to platinum. Frankly, there are marriages that didn't last that long. If you like the race then you should find that you can pick up most of the bronze and silver awards without too much trouble, but there is a quartet of gold trophies that will most likely leave you with road rage. The biggest hurdle you will face in your quest for Gran Turismo Sport fame is the Record Number of Victories trophy, which gives you the record of Michael Schumacher's 91st Formula One victory. And you have to do it online against other people in sports mode. Aside from the massive commitment time is required, the more you win the more you will rank and the stronger your competitors will become, meaning this trophy becomes harder the closer you get. This one really separates serious racers from those who are just driving to a local castle to test their sight. Honestly, we don't even know how to pronounce the name of this game, which is a bad start. This remaster of the niche combat game KoihimefEnbu contains a number of trophies that unlock through pulling off an incredibly sophisticated combo. We're not talking about ten hit combos here, kids. We're talking 75 combos that need to be precisely entered with small margins for errors. Even watching videos of people doing it on YouTube was hard. And and This is. If you're not an android or some kind of prodigy, you're probably not going to get this one. You need thumbs and fingers that move with the precision and dexterity of an experienced jazz musician, and unfortunately, our days of bugle games are long over. Ok here it goes: I first bought Wipeout HD back in January 2010, ever since I was chasing 3 trophies that I could never get them: Beat ziko Rich zone zevs (Zone 75) Get all the campaign on elite gold badges and history repeated 7 years later hahaha. The thing is that I know how to play it, played it with PSX! but, I just don't know if there are some specific ships to use (and leather). With the trophy to reach the zeus zone I couldn't go any further than zone 58 (did it in Syncopia), I've seen a lot of YouTube videos for the aforementioned trophies and so far I can't adjust my skills. Would you guys be so kind to let me know what I need in order to get these 2 platinum? I do look at them ahead, but it seems that after thousands of hours of practice, does not pay.
