Garrett Morgan

(March 4, 1877, Paris, Kentucky –
July 27, 1963, Cleveland, Ohio)

Some of his inventions were: the protective 'smoke hood' used in a 1916 tunnel construction disaster rescue. traffic signal: a three-way traffic light invented in 1923. hair-straightening cream: developed in the 1920s. hair straightening comb



Marie Van Brittan Brown

(October 22, 1922, Manhattan, New York –
February 2, 1999, Jamaica, Queens, New York)

In 1966, invented the first closed-circuit television security system and paved the way for modern home security systems used today. In 1969, Brown and her husband received a patent for the invention. She is also credited with the invention of the first closed circuit television.



Edward Alexander Bouchet

(September 15, 1852, New Haven, Connecticut –
October 28, 1918, New Haven)

A renowned physicist and the first African American to earn a Ph.D. in the United States, as well as the sixth person to earn a doctorate in physics from an American university, which he received from Yale University in 1876. Bouchet was one of the first African Americans elected to Phi Beta Kappa - the leading academic honour society in the United States.

THE SOLICITATION
