Actor, Author J.R. Martinez and Assurant to Salute Inductees for Their Resilience During May 27 Ceremony

"We want people from coast to coast to hear the incredible stories of our Perseverance Hall of Fame inductees and how they used the experience for the good of others," says Joe Sevcik, senior vice president of marketing at Assurant Employee Benefits. "Together, their motivational stories and our charitable grants to support organizations that encourage perseverance will help more people make big comebacks from illness or injury."

Following the induction ceremony, opera soprano Tillemann-Dick will perform a concert featuring selections from her best-selling classical CD, *American Grace*.
