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## European paediatric advanced life support pdf

The EPALS course is designed for all health care professionals who may be involved, either as a team member or team leader, in the intensive care unit of a child, infant or newborn, whether in the hospital or outside the hospital. The course aims to provide caregivers with the knowledge and skills needed to manage seriously ill children during the first hour of illness, as well as to prevent progression to cardiac arrest. Particular attention is also paid to team management and non-technical skills. The course takes 2 full days (or up to 3 days) and includes: Recognition of seriously ill children Snowing and skills in assessing and treating respiratory problems, Breathing and circulation (including mask-mask ventilation) Intraosseous infusion Management shock Scenario-based training in the management of seriously ill children Bastage life support Treatment of suffocation Unant life support Advanced algorithms of cardiac cardiac cardiac shock and non-shock rhythms, defibrillation Scenario-based learning in management (inevitable) cardiac arrest (inevitable) cardiac arrest Severe injuries and special circumstances; With a focus on non-technical skills and the team approach Post-resuscitation care and ethics This course is now fully booked, if you would like to be added to the waiting list, please complete your data on this link European Pediatric Advanced Life support (EPALS) course is a collaboration between the European Council of Resuscitation and Resuscitation Council (UK). The EPLS course was launched in 2003, but was renamed EPALS in 2016. The course is designed to train interdisciplinary health professionals to recognize a child in respiratory or circulatory failure and to develop the knowledge and basic skills needed to prevent further deterioration to respiratory or cardiorespiratory arrests. EPALS is approved by the Royal Colleges of Emergency Medicine, Pediatrics, Anesthesia and the Association of Pediatric Anesthesiologists (RCPCH, RCEM, RCA, APA) for training and re-evaluation for both consultants and junior classes in advanced pediatric resuscitation and management skills. Who is fit for this course? The EPALS course is designed for health care professionals who must apply the skills they teach as part of their clinical duties, or train them on a regular basis. The participants concerned are doctors, nurses and paramedics working in direct contact with children. All applicants must have ongoing clinical appointment and professional qualifications in health care. Medical students in the last year of study can be accepted as candidates. The results of the EPALS training should allow you: to use the structured ABCDE approach to quickly assess a seriously ill child; Manage a sick child until expert care arrives; contribute to the development of Group members and leaders; Use a structured approach to communication between team members during an emergency Cors structure EPALS courses are held in centers across the UK and are approved and certified by the Resuscitation Board (UK). This ensures that the content and the standard are uniform regardless of the center. The course takes place within two days. All candidates will be registered with the Learning Management System (LMS) to access the Multiple Choice (MC) questionnaire, course evaluation and post-course certificates. The course program consists of lectures, seminars, station skills and modeling teaching. Please note that the seats are not confirmed until a payment is made. All of our Courses Centres are approved and certified by the UK Resuscitation Board. The courses are led by dedicated and qualified instructors who have completed an RCUK instructor course to ensure that our courses are uniform and the content remains the same in our course centers. Before the start of the course, you be registered with our Training Management System (LMS). Here you can access the course modules, a document with several choices before the course (MC). Candidates will receive a course guide a month before the start of the course. Applicants must read the guide in preparation for the course and submit a completed document before the START of the MC course. Program: Within two days, candidates will take part in lectures, interactive seminars, skills stations and simulations focused on the deterioration of children with pediatric diseases, heart failure management and trauma. Download the full Assessment and Certification program: During the course, candidates will be continually evaluated based on their effectiveness in clinical simulations. You will need to be competent in basic course skills, including managing seriously ill/injured children, managing the airways, high quality CPR and defibrillation, and managing cardiac arrest. The course ends with a final assessment consisting of a simulation and an MC document. Candidates who have successfully completed the course will be awarded a certificate from the UK EPALS Resuscitation Board, which is valid for four years and is recognised in medical institutions in the UK and Europe. This course is recognized as Continuous Professional Development (CPD) by the Royal College of Medicine, Dental and Nursing and the Professional Health Council. Re-certification If the course certificate expires, you can re-certify by sowing the course within twelve months of the certificate expiring. To change, you just need to take the second day of the standard EPALS course. When you contact the Courses Center to book a seat on the course, make sure you tell them that you want a re-certification. The EPALS course is a certified course of the European Resuscitation Council (ERC) and is designed for all medical professionals who can participate in providing seriously ill children in the first 30-60 minutes (newborn, baby, larger child), whether in hospital or in pre-hospital care. The aim of the course is to equip participants with theoretical knowledge and practical skills necessary to care for a child with respiratory or circulatory failure for various reasons, as well as to prevent the progression of the critical condition into cardiac arrest. Training focuses on teamwork skills in the intensive care unit and management team, mutual communication and cooperation between medical professionals. Who is this course for? The course is intended exclusively for health professionals who, in normal clinical practice, can provide extended emergency resuscitation in children or treat seriously ill children in the performance of their duties or provide them with training. The most frequent participants in the course are doctors of all specialties, especially doctors in the field of emergency medicine, anesthesiology and intensive care, as well as paramedics and nurses working in intensive or intensive care units, operating theatres, emergency hospitals or emergency medicine. The condition for participation in the course is the performance of clinical practice and completed medical education, for example, completed education at the university or the highest vocational school of medical orientation, secondary medical school or medical faculty (exemption can be granted only to students of the 5th and 6th courses, if their number on the course does not exceed 10% of the total number of participants). Pre-course training Program course includes practical skills training, master classes, simulated scenarios and final exams. All participants receive an official guide (in English) by mail no later than a month before the start of the course and at the same time get access to the textbook in the electronic version (PDF download on the Internet erc.edu for all registered participants). ERC also allows all registered EPALS participants on their website access to the electronic part of the course, the so-called VLE, a virtual learning environment. The electronic training part summarizes the theoretical knowledge needed to complete the practical part of the course itself. VLE also includes a preliminary test course, which must be taken by all participants in the course. The EPALS course itself is focused on the integration of knowledge and the preparation of practical skills and provides for a separate study of theoretical foundations in advance. As the practical part of the course (full two-day part) does not contain lectures, but only interactive discussions, workshops and practical rehearsals. Please come to the course ready to make the most of it! Read the tutorial and read the online part of the course and preparations. This test does not affect the overall rating, it serves only as a basis for evaluating the progress of individual participants. The number of attempts to pass pre-sold is not limited. It is expected that the participant must receive a rating of at least 70% before completing the practical part.
