

Focus collection of Japanese Journal of Applied Physics

Authors of accepted abstracts are encouraged to submit their original papers on the significant part of their work presented at this symposium to the Focus Collection (former Special Issue) of Japanese Journal of Applied Physics (JJAP) on Advanced Science and Technology of Silicon and Related Materials 2026 (JSAP Si Symposium 2026).

All papers submitted to the Focus Collection will be reviewed according to the same peer-review standards and acceptance criteria as regular JJAP papers. Submitted manuscripts must present original work containing new data and/or discussions and must not include material that has been previously published elsewhere in substantially the same form.

Submission Deadline: November 13, 2026 (Submission Opens: October 13, 2026)

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Note: Submissions made after the deadline and submissions from authors who did not present at this symposium will be rejected without peer review.

Article type

Regular Paper: original papers with comprehensive, detailed descriptions of the research work, presenting a fully developed discussion on the results obtained in relevant fields of applied physics. They must provide sufficient and self-contained information to ensure the repeatability of experiments and analyses by readers. There is no length limit for Regular Papers; however, the abstract should not exceed 150 words. Appropriate references should be listed; a typical Regular Paper should include 30 or more appropriate references.

Brief Note: short reports on significant improvements in instrumentation, fabrication processes, measurement techniques, and theoretical analyses, and also serve as an archive of knowledge useful for applied physics, such as important material parameters. The maximum length of a Brief Note is 2,700 words and 3 single-column width figures. An abstract of no more than 100 words should be provided. Other than this, Brief Notes should not be divided into sections. Appropriate references should be listed; a typical Brief Note should include 20 or more appropriate references.

Progress Review: concise and efficient overviews covering the latest progress in a specific research area of applied physics. They can include or be largely based on the recent results from the author(s). There is no length limit, although the manuscript should be written as concisely as possible and the abstract should not exceed 150 words.

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
