According to the official CEFR guidelines, someone at the A2 level in English: can understand sentences and often use expressions related to the areas most relevant (e.g. very basic personal and family information, shopping, local geography, employment). Can communicate in simple and routine tasks that require simple and direct exchange of information on familiar and routine issues. One can simply describe aspects of his or her origin, the immediate surroundings and issues in areas in need of immediate need.
