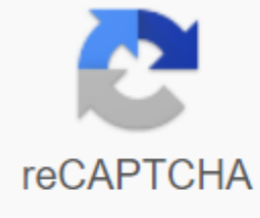

At first glance, it may seem a bit overwhelming, but it's manageable if you know what to expect. Read on to find out when to send everything from saving dates to thank you for the notes and who to send them to. Chances are you'll make more trips to the post office than you have in your life, but these invitational things that you (and your guests) will look back on as precious souvenirs in years to come. Elnora Turner/Brides Traditional wedding invitation package includes a basic invitation, answer card and any other body card containing useful information for your guests (reception card, travel and accommodation map, clothing card, wedding card, etc.). Send wedding invitations six to eight weeks before your wedding date. It's all on your guest list. RSVPs must be due one month before the wedding. A good rule of thumb is to call a wedding at least half an hour to 45 minutes before you want the ceremony to begin and find out what time is at your invitation. It is also important to be very deliberate with what you plan to have guests make for this window time before the ceremony starts. It is important to make it very purposeful. You don't want your guests sitting in their seats waiting or thinking you're late, says etiquette expert Elaine Swann. There is something ready for your guests to do. It doesn't take much, but you want to create a moment that allows your guests to come at this time and get involved. Meet the expert Elaine Swann is a lifestyle and wedding etiquette expert. She is the founder of Swann School of Protocol and author of Let Crazy Be Crazy. According to Swann, something as simple as serving a spa water, creating a photo area, or signing a guest book is a great way to fill this time intentionally and be sure that guests don't sit and wait too long. Listing this action on a portable program or a big sign is another great way to make it clear that the start time was intentional. If you only invite a few foreign guests, send your invitations with for other guests but make a point to give them them Call them or send them an email with details, as well as hotel room reservations, so they can start organizing their journey with spare time. Half your family lives abroad? You may want to consider bumping into deadlines for them and the rest of your guests. Start designing invitations a few weeks early and plan to send them at least 12 weeks in advance. Be sure to keep an eye out quickly with someone you haven't heard of to make sure they have enough time to book their flights. You also want all the information available on your wedding website as soon as you keep the dates in the mail. Of course, this means that you will have to start ironing out the hotel room block and transport information earlier than you expected, but you will be happier in the long run. While save date cards are not required, they are a fun way to get your guests to mark their calendars. They are also especially useful when many of your guests have to take travel arrangements or if accommodation near the wedding site is limited. Four to six months before the wedding, or even earlier, if you are planning a wedding appointment, that may require more extensive travel arrangements. Often, the couple's parents or close friends will throw a party participation where the couple announces the big news. For gifts received during the engagement and soul party, send thanks for two or three weeks after the celebration; For gifts sent before the wedding date, send the card as soon as possible, but definitely before the wedding; For gifts given on the wedding day, send a thank-you note within three months; and for gifts received after the wedding, send one within two to three weeks.
