IN THE MOUNTAIN KIJANG PROTECTED FOREST ON BEHALF OF THE KEPRI
DHARMA BUDDHA EDUCATION FOUNDATION
IN BINTAN DISTRICT, RIAU ISLANDS PROVINCE

GOVERNOR OF RIAU ISLANDS,

Weigh:

- a. that business activities for utilizing natural tourism environmental services in Production Forests comply with the provisions of Minister of Forestry Regulation Number P.31/MenLHK/Setjen/Kum.1/3/2016 concerning Guidelines for Business Activities for Utilizing Natural Tourism Environmental Services in Protected Forests and Regulations of the Minister of Environment and Forestry Number: P.22/MENLHK/SETJEN/KUM.1/ 7/2018 concerning Norms, Standards, Procedures and Criteria for Electronically Integrated Licensing Services Scope of the Ministry of Environment and Forestry, implemented based on the Business Permit for Utilization of Natural Tourism Environmental Services for Providing Natural Tourism Facilities in Protected Forests issued by the Governor;
- b. that heed the request of the Chairman of the Kepri Buddha Dharma Education Foundation number 08/S- YPBD/XII/2019 dated 3 December 2019 regarding the Application for a Business Permit for the Utilization of Natural Tourism Environmental Services for the Provision of Natural Tourism Facilities (IUPJL- PSWA) in HL Gunung Kijang Bintan 41.07 Hectares ;
- c. that based on the letter from the Head of the Riau Islands Province Environment and Forestry Service number 522.12/1018/DLHK/5.0/2019 dated 23 December 2019 regarding the Assessment of Applications for Protected Forest IUPJL-PSWA. Kepri Buddhist Dharma Education Foundation;
- d. that based on the letter from the Head of the One Stop Investment and Integrated Services Service of the Riau Islands Province number 570/06/DPMPTSP-05/2020 dated 07 January 2020 regarding the Order to Fulfill the Commitment of the Riau Islands Buddhist Dharma Education Foundation at HL Gunung Kijang, Bintan Regency;
- e. that based on the letter from the Head of the Riau Islands Province Environment and Forestry Service Number B/120/289/DLHK/2020 dated 22 May 2020 regarding the Assessment of Fulfillment of Commitments and Technical Recommendations for Business Permits for the Utilization of Environmental Services An. Kepri Buddhist Dharma Education Foundation;

- f. that in order to fulfill the intent as stated in letter a, letter b, letter c, letter d and letter e, it is necessary to stipulate a Business Permit for the Utilization of Environmental Services for Natural Tourism Provision of Natural Tourism Facilities (IUPJL-PSWA) in the Gunung Kijang Protected Forest in the name of the Buddha Dharma Kepri Education Foundation in Bintan Regency, Riau Islands Province;
- g. that based on the considerations as referred to in letters a, b, c, d, e and f, it is necessary to stipulate a Decree of the Governor of the Riau Islands;

DECIDE :

Set

FIRST

: Business Permit for Utilization of Environmental Services for Natural Tourism Provision of Natural Tourism Facilities (IUPJL-PSWA) in the Gunung Kijang Protected Forest in the Name of the Buddha Dharma Kepri Education Foundation in Bintan Regency, Riau Islands Province.

SECOND

: Business Licenses as referred to in the FIRST dictum are granted to:

THIRD

: The area granted a Business Permit for the Utilization of Environmental Services for Natural Tourism Provision of Natural Tourism Facilities in the Gunung Kijang Protected Forest is \pm 41.07 hectares and the area permitted for the construction of natural tourism facilities is a maximum of \pm 4.1 hectares, with

The types of facilities and infrastructure activities that may be built include:

- a. Water Tourism Facilities;
- b. Accommodation Facilities;
- c. Transportation Facilities;
- d. Adventure Tourism;
- e. Educational Tourism;
- f. Hunting Tourism;
- g. Special Interest Sports; and
- h. Rest Area

With coordinate points and maps as listed in the attachment to this Decision.

FOURTH

: The Kepri Buddha Dharma Education Foundation is obliged to:

- a. Realizing the development of natural tourism facilities in accordance with the Natural Tourism Management Plan.
- b. If the regulation regarding the amount of Business contributions has been issued, the Buddha Dharma Kepri Education Foundation must be able to complete its contribution payment obligations in accordance with what has been stipulated.
- c. Paying Forest Product Levy for Utilization of Environmental Services for Natural Tourism in accordance with the provisions of laws and regulations.
- d. Implementing security of the area and its potential as well as management and security of visitors in the IUPSWA-HL area.
- e. Maintaining cleanliness of the business environment including waste and garbage management.
- f. Rehabilitate damage caused by IUPSWA-HL activities.
- g. Provide access to appointed government officials to monitor, supervise, evaluate and foster IUPSWA-HL activities.
- h. Maintaining State assets for permit holders who use government facilities.
- i. Involving experts in the field of nature conservation and utilization of natural tourism environmental services, as well as local communities in implementing IUPSWA-HL activities in accordance with the permits granted.
- j. Making periodic reports on business activities in providing natural tourism facilities to the Director General, Governor, relevant Regent/Mayor, head of the Provincial SKPD in charge of Forestry and Tourism, and the head of the local KPH.

FIFTH

: The Buddha Dharma Kepri Education Foundation has the right to:

- a. Carry out business activities according to the permit.
- b. Become a member of a nature tourism business association.
- c. Get legal protection in doing business
- d. Utilizing natural tourism facilities that belong to the state.

SIXTH:

In terms of the Implementation of the Development of Natural Tourism Infrastructure, it is prohibited to build permanent infrastructure, cut down trees or damage forest areas. If forest damage occurs in the area for which permission has been granted, it is the responsibility of the Kepri Buddha Dharma Education Foundation.

SEVENTH


: The Business Permit for Utilization of Environmental Services for Natural Tourism for Providing Natural Tourism Facilities (IUPJL-PSWA) in the Gunung Kijang Protected Forest is granted for 35 (thirty five) years and can be extended in accordance with statutory regulations.

SIXTH:

This Governor's Decree shall come into force on the date of its stipulation, with the provision that if there is an error in the stipulation of this Decree, then corrections will be made as appropriate.

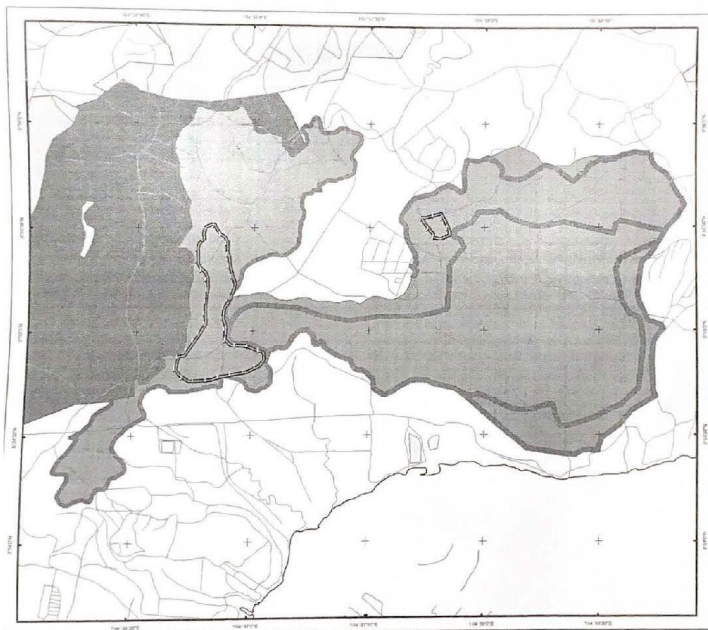
