In 1972 Agnetha Fältskog, Björn Ulvaeus, Benny Andersson and Anni-Frid (Frida) formed Lyngstad in Stockholm, Sweden. It became one of the most successful groups in music history. After the Broadway show came the mammoth hit movies Mamma Mia! and Mamma Mia! Here we go again. 'Mamma Mia!' movie recap Released in 2008, the first movie, Mamma Mia! located on a fictional Greek island. Finally, the three fathers offer to walk Sophie down the aisle; Donna professes her love for Sam (he's still in love with her too); Sophie decides she's really too young to get married, and Donna and Sam get married! All this happens - we shouldn't wish this could be for real life, too - to the melodies of Dancing Queen, Waterloo, Lay All Your Love On Me and Super Trouper. And here's where we got away with Mamma Mia! Here we go again' Donna is dead and her daughter tries to reopen Donna's decomposed hotel in this sequel, which came around in 2018, 10 years after her Younger Donna is played in Mamma Mia! Here We Go Again by Lily James, with Meryl Streep as older Donna in a couple of places. Throughout the film, there are flashbacks of Donna's past with Sophie's possible three fathers. Sophie reveals that she and her now-husband Sky are expecting a baby and to top the film off, her grandmother Ruby, played by Cher (had we expected anything less?), making a spectacular entrance by helicopter. Throughout their career, the band has sold 400 million records worldwide. ABBA is the fourth best-selling musical performer in history behind #3 Michael Jackson (450 million albums sold), #2 Elvis (550 million) and #1 The Beatles (600 million). Nearly a decade after it first appeared on theatrical stages and was later staged in more than 170 cities around the world, the filmadaptation of the hit musical Mamma Mia! was released in cinemas in the summer of 2008. The film features Meryl Streep, Julie Walters, Christine Baranski, Colin Firth, Pierce Brosnan, Stellan Skarsgård, Dominic Cooper and Amanda Seyfried. The actors also lent their vocal talents to the soundtrack to the movie musical that had already impressed audiences around the world. The soundtrack to the film, which was released in July 2008, has songs originally recorded by ABBA included Dancing Queen and SOS as performed by the actors. Mamma Mia! is about Sophie, a bride (Amanda Seyfried) who finds out from her mother's diary that her father may be one of three men - Sam Carmichael (Pierce Brosnan), Bill Anderson (Stellan Skarsgård) or Harry Bright (Colin Firth). The resulting joyful and comical negotiations with the three potential fathers mean that both Sophie and Donna are completely unsure of who their father really is and are told through the BBC's chart-topping music. It is little surprise why the stage musical - and later film - was such a hit with audiences all over the world. The Mamma Mia! film soundtrack has been a great success, topped #1 on the US Billboard 200 chart and was certified platinum. It also topped the US Billboard Top Soundtracks Chart. It also hit #1 in nearly two dozen other countries, including Australia, Sweden, Ireland, Austria, Greece, Spain, Norway, Poland and Canada. Over 5 million copies have been sold worldwide, far surpassing the original London cast recording of the stage musical. The film itself is the highest-grossing non-animated musical of all time, earning \$609.8 million worldwide, meaning both Mamma Mia! film and film soundtracks can be considered great successes for the actors. The album was nominated for a Grammy Award for Best Compilation album for Motion Picture, Television or Other Visual Media. The original ABBA member Benny Andersson not only produced the film, but he also played piano and keyboards on the album (both Andersson and abba member Björn Ulvaeus have cameo appearances in the film). Rutger Gunnarsson, who played bass and bouzouki on some of ABC's original hits, also contributed to the soundtrack.
