

Thank you for purchasing Mom's Mason Jar Rack

Included parts:

- 2 - Mason Jar Racks (a)
- 2 - Wall Mounting Clips (b)
- 8 - 3/4 mounting screws
- 4 - Drywall Anchors and screws
- 8 - Plastic Rivets and screws
- 1 - Instruction Manual



Installation:

You can install the Jar Rack in one of several configurations, including on the wall, on a pegboard or under a shelf or cabinet:

IMPORTANT: When inserting jars in to the Jar Rack make sure that the edges of the Jar Rack are holding onto the neck of the jar and not onto the band or thread. Failing to do so may result in the jars not being secured correctly and slipping out of the rack.

Under Shelf / Under Cabinet Installation:

1. Select an area under a shelf or under a cabinet where you would like to install the Jar Rack.
 2. **IMPORTANT:** Make sure that the selected shelf or cabinet bottom is sturdy and can support the added weight of the jars.
 3. Using an electric screwdriver and the included 3/4 inch mounting screws fasten the jar rack to the bottom of the selected surface. (use the 4 holes in the center of the jar rack) (Fig 1.1)
 4. If mounting multiple Jar Racks next to each other, leave at least 1/4 inch gap between each set or racks (failing to do so may result in difficult time inserting and removing jars from the jar racks) (Fig. 1.2)
- * The wall mounting bracket will not be used for this installation





Wall Installation:

Drywall

1. Place the wall mounting bracket horizontal on the wall at the desired location. (Fig 2.1)
2. Using a pencil, mark the location of the 2 top holes onto the wall.
3. Set aside the Wall Mounting Bracket
4. Using a drill bit drill 2 holes in to the wall (Fig 2.2)
5. Insert the Drywall Anchors in to the holes (Fig 2.3)
6. Position the Wall Mounting Bracket onto the wall so that the gap is between the center section of the bracket and the wall (the bracket will bulge out in the middle)
7. Using a screwdriver and the included Drywall Anchor Screws, fasten the Wall Mounting Bracket onto the wall (Fig 2.4)
8. Ensure that the Drywall Anchors are fully engaged and the bracket is sturdy
9. Insert the Jar Rack in to the mounting bracket. (Fig 2.5)
10. If desired you may insert a pin (cotter pin) in the hole located on the top front part of the jar rack. This will prevent jars from accidentally sliding out









Wooden wall surface

1. Place the Wall Mounting Bracket horizontal on the wall at the desired location.
2. Position the Wall Mounting Bracket onto the wall so that the gap is between the center section of the bracket and the wall (the bracket will bulge out in the middle)
3. Using a screwdriver and the included 3/4 inch mounting screws fasten the bracket onto the wall (Fig 3.1)
4. Ensure that the bracket is sturdy
5. Insert the Jar Rack in to the mounting bracket. (Fig 3.2)
6. If desired you may insert a pin (cotter pin) in the hole located on the top front part of the jar rack. This will prevent jars from accidentally sliding out





Peg Board

1. Insert the plastic rivets in to the 4 holes of the wall mounting bracket (Fig 4.1)
2. Position the Wall Mounting Bracket onto the pegboard so that the gap is between the center section of the bracket and the board (the bracket will bulge out in the middle)
3. Using a screwdriver and the included plastic rivet screws, fasten the bracket onto the peg board (Note: Do not use an electric screw driver as it may damage the plastic screws) (Fig 4.2)
4. Ensure that the bracket is sturdy
5. Insert the Jar Rack in to the mounting bracket. (Fig 4.3)
6. If desired you may insert a pin (cotter pin) in the hole located on the top front part of the jar rack. This will prevent jars from accidentally sliding out







Troubleshooting:

Q: It is difficult to insert or remove a jar in to the Jar Rack.

A: While Mom's Mason Jar Racks are designed to easily accommodate most regular mouth mason jars, the neck of some jars is not completely round but rather elliptical. Rotating the jar slightly to the left or to the right will likely solve the problem.

Q: Can I hang jars without the bands?

A: Yes, you may hang jars with or without bands
