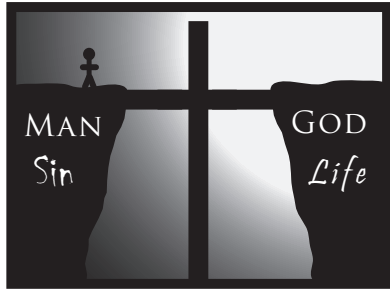


Jesus can save you.

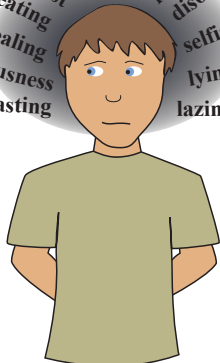
(Matthew 7:13-14).

"There is a way which seemeth right unto a man; but the end thereof are the ways of death" (Prov. 14:12).

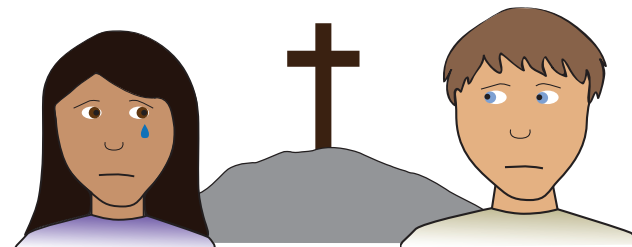
There is nothing we can give God to save ourselves. Our efforts, works, and rituals are an offensive payment for the great debt we owe.
