## 11. Our Journey Through November

Our journey through November is a reminder to us once again that nature has worked its way through the seasons of growth and gathering and has already settled down to winter rest. Winter is the story of nature's way in which all life winds down and returns, each in its own time, to the earth. During this time we notice, firstly, the array of colour on display as death and sleep

has taken over the natural world. We find ourselves thinking "how amazingly colourful death can be!" They all learned what it was to be a leaf clinging to the branch not wanting to let go but then, in a moment of surrender, let go to disappear into a long and gentle rest, their spirits mingling with the spirit of the living creator God. Grant them eternal rest, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them!
