PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

I acknowledge that participation in any activity at Grace Community Center (GCC) involves risk to the participant (and to the participant's parents or guardians, if the participant is a minor), and may result in various types of injury including, but not limited to, the following: sickness, exposure to infectious/communicable disease, bodily injury, death, emotional injury, personal injury, property damage, and financial damage. In consideration for the opportunity to participate in any activity at GCC, the participant (or parent/guardian if the participant is a minor) acknowledges and accepts the risks of injury associated with participation in and transportation to and from the activity. The participant (or parent/guardian) accepts personal financial responsibility for any injury or other loss sustained during the activity or during transportation to and from the activity, as well as for any medical treatment rendered to the participant that is authorized by GCC or its agents, employees, volunteers, or any other representatives (collectively referred to as the "GCC"). Further, the participant (or parent/guardian) releases and promises to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless GCC for any injury arising directly or indirectly out of the activity or transportation to and from the activity, whether such injury arises out of the negligence of GCC, the participant, or otherwise. If a dispute over this agreement or any claim for damages arises, the participant (or parent/guardian) agrees to resolve the matter through a mutually acceptable alternative dispute resolution process. If the participant (or parent/guardian) and GCC cannot agree upon such a process, the dispute will be submitted to a three-member arbitration panel for resolution in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association.
