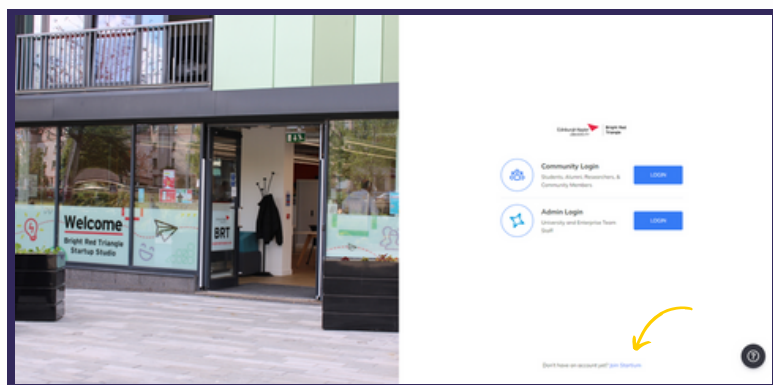




Registering with BRT

Step 1: Access the Registration Page

Visit <https://platform.startium.co.uk/university/brt> and click "Join Startium" at the bottom of the page.

Ignore this message if you're a Student affiliated with QMU or EC

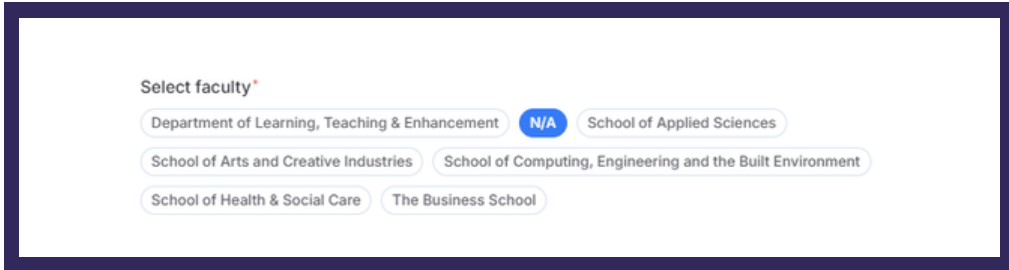
Students – Select “Student” if you are a current student. *This includes students from partner universities such as QMU or EC. You may ignore any message suggesting otherwise.*

Student - Select your ENU School and Course from the list. If you are from QMU or EC please select N/A and add these details when you build your profile at a later stage.

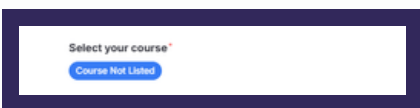

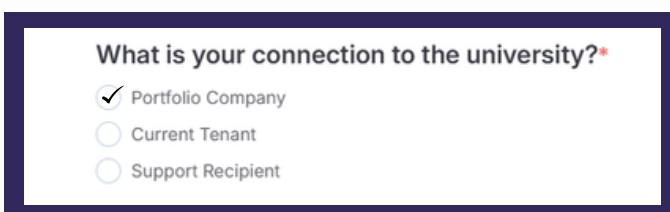

Step 3: Create Your Logins and Verify Your Email

Check your email for a pin from "Enterprise team" or "no-reply@startium.co.uk". Enter this pin on the registration page. Note: Use an email address you check regularly. It does not have to be your academic email address

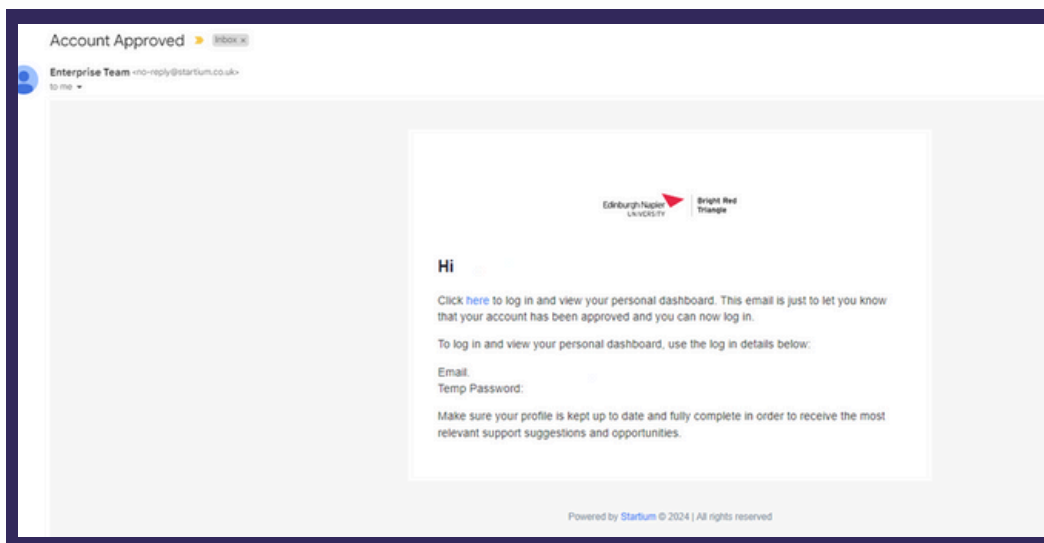
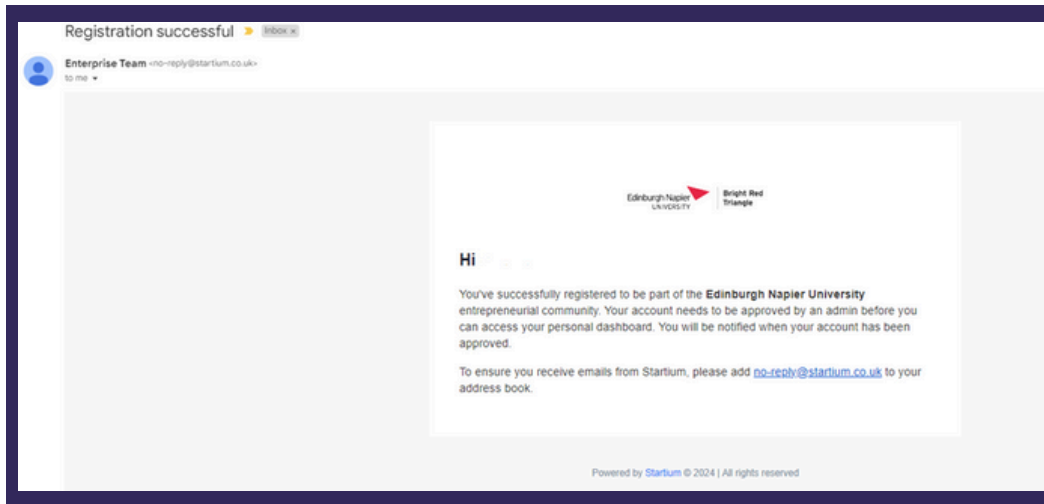

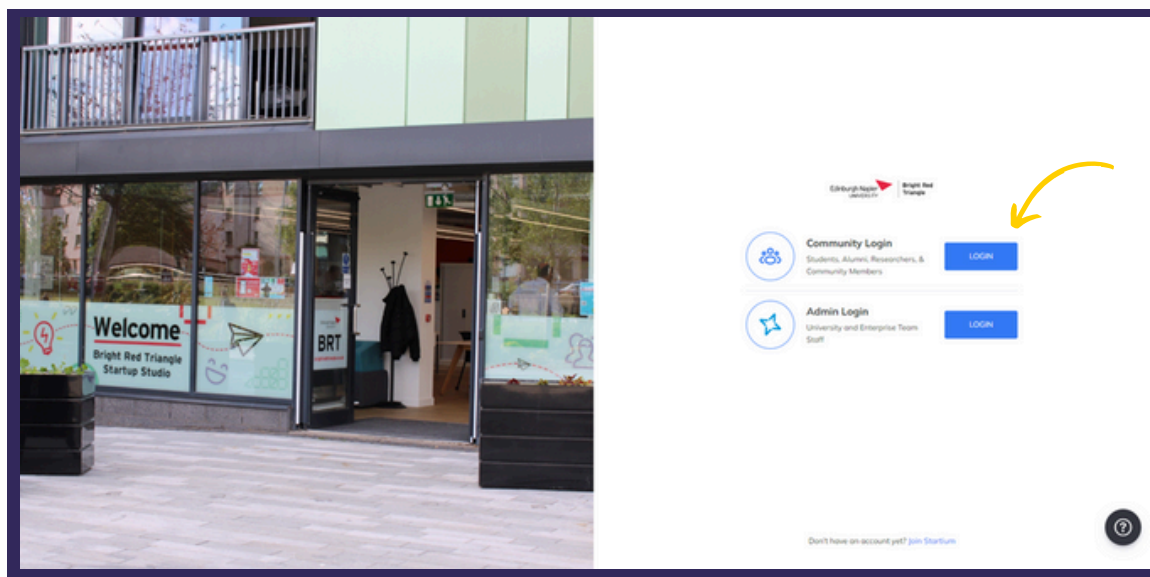
Step 5: Confirmation and Approval

You will receive an email confirming your registration and pending admin approval, usually within 24 hours (excluding weekends).



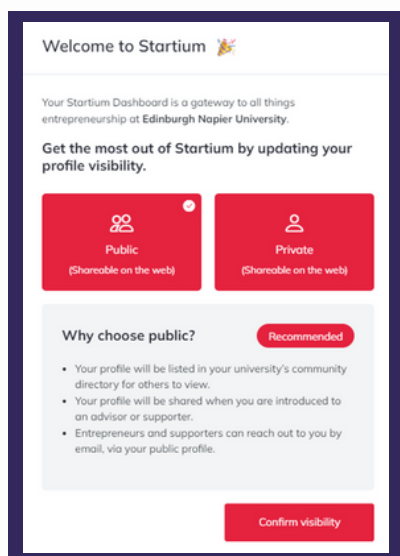
Step 6: Logging In

Once approved. Log in using "Community Login", and enter your email and password.

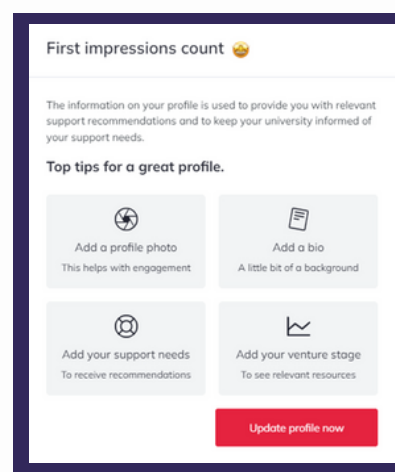


Step 7: Complete Your Profile

We recommend booking a 1:1 meeting with one of our Enterprise Managers.

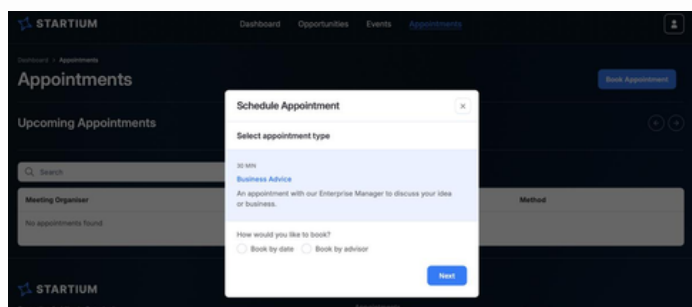
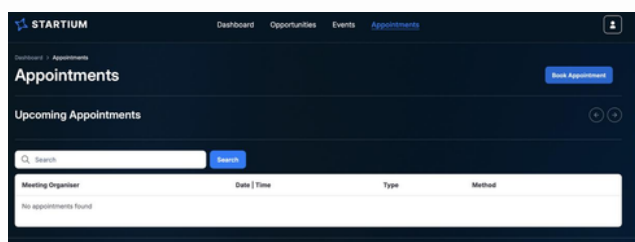
