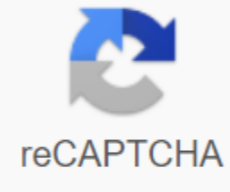

From traveling in the off-season to booking special budget ticket packages, these money-saving tips help you avoid high prices for entry, meals and even accommodation for your stay in Los Angeles. Whether it's your first trip to the happiest place on Earth or you're trying to save money on your last trip to Disneyland, you don't need to break the bank to enjoy this world famous amusement park. Remember also that children under the age of 3 get in at reduced rates like Disneyland and Disney California Adventure theme parks while kids ages 3 to 9 only pay the ticket price of youth, and children 10 and older pay an adult admission level. Although prices vary by date, normal admission rates (per day) for 2019 are: One-day cost: \$97Single-Day Regular: \$117Single-Day Peak: \$135Two-1wo-1 Daily Season: \$105Three-Day Pass: \$93.34Four-Day Pass: \$76.25Five-Day Pass: \$64 Disney introduced a model of skyrocketing one-day ticket prices at Disneyland. This means that entry prices are now fluctuating with demand, with higher prices during peak periods (think holidays and weekends) and lower prices in slower seasons, reflecting the fluctuation in seasonal room rates that have long existed at Disneyland resorts. So it makes more sense than ever to visit when Disneyland is the least crowded. If your family can be flexible and visit at less crowded times, such as midweek during the school year, your tickets will cost less. However, if you visit on weekends, school breaks, or holidays, your ticket prices will be This peak time. There are three tiers for theme park tickets for one day: cost, regular and peak days. Disney uses its crowd calendars to classify days and one-day tickets are being assigned to a specific day of use. One-day tickets at a price Disneyland Park and Disney California Adventures cost \$97 for adults on days' worth, \$110 on normal days, and \$124 on peak days. To save time when you arrive, you can purchase tickets to the Disneyland Resort Park on the official website or through the Disneyland mobile app. When buying tickets using these methods, you can get either a physical ticket or a Disney eTicket that are delivered in PDF that can be viewed and printed on most desktop and mobile devices. In 2017, Disneyland launched Disney MaxPass, which allows mobile booking and redemption of Disney FastPass time to return through the Disneyland app. Disney MaxPass is available for \$20 a day. Disneyland Resort Annual Passholders also have the option to purchase Disney MaxPass on a daily or annual basis, and MaxPass will also give guests unlimited downloads of their PhotoPass images. Disney tickets vary. For example, one day of the ticket expires on the chosen start day. However, the 10-day ticket expires 14 days after the first day of use. So if you buy a 10-day ticket for May 1 and use it that day for a reception at Disneyland, you'll be able to visit one Disney theme park on any of your remaining days from May 2 to May 14. After that, the ticket expires and all unused days are lost. If you visit Disneyland for more than one day, seasonal prices do not apply to multi-day tickets, the cost of which is much less per day than for one-day tickets. In a nutshell, every day is added to the ticket reduces the cost per day, so if you want to get the lowest ticket price possible, you should purchase a multi-day ticket and visit another park every day at a lower price. If you buy a three-day or longer ticket online, you'll also get a great value in a shake-up called Magic Morning, which is an early one-day reception during your stay at Disneyland Park an hour before the park opens to the public. This gives you access to a selection of rides and rides before the crowds hit the park. However, if you only have one day to enjoy Disney Parks in Los Angeles, you can buy a hopper ticket that allows you to access more than one park per day for the same price. For example, you can visit Disney California Adventure in the morning and then head to Disneyland in the afternoon. However, the Park Hopper option is sold as a supplement.
