


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Itinerary template bachelorette free

Think dusty, cactus-strewn hikes mixed with destination-worthy vintage stores, divey salons sometimes populated by IRL rock stars, and the famous meditation space originally designed to be inspired by Venus (or so its creator claimed). While you can certainly mosey right on into town, you may first want to unpack from the journey (and, you Life) with a one-night stay at Two Bunch Palms is a hot springs resort located off the 10 Freeway near Joshua Tree. Here you can simply soak up the naturally heated mineral waters of the 600-year spring spring Enjoy a wellness experience ranging from mud baths to water yoga reiki to sound vibration healing and beyond. If you decide to skip straight to Joshua Tree and want to go along the hotel route, take your choice of city one-of-a-kind accommodation (no hotel chains are allowed in the area). Spin and Margie's Desert Hideaway offers five quintessential desert cabins with kitchens and shared open space, boasting horseshoes and ball-court bocce. The Mojave Sands Motel is another cabin-oriented option that includes outdoor baths to cool down under the stars at the end of a long desert day. The Pioneertown Motel, meanwhile, is a legendary property originally built by Roy Rogers in the 1940s for the stars of Western films that have recently been renovated. Of your options, this may be the most photogenic; However, it's a bit of a drive for most of Joshua Tree's attractions except for the famous musical locations of Pappy and Harriet (more on that in a minute). Finally, you can always choose a dose of romantic morbidity at the Joshua Tree Inn, where in the late 60s, early 70s musician Graham Parsons famously died. If renting a home is all the more your style, check out Acido Dorado. Your insta-friends will be impressed by his architectural dazzle. Large groups, however, might want to consider instead a villa that offers a rare area (and potentially important as temps broil) to have its own pool on the property. Additional Airbnb options abound, too, including glamping options such as this Lazy Sky property. After check-in, head to Pie for the People for a truly memorable pizza - try a slice of Bowie or live to regret it, followed by a saddle for drinks and karaoke at the Joshua Tree Salon. (You know you want to sing! I just don't know what to do with myself outside the key a la Cameron Diaz at my best friend's wedding, like a strange mix of locals, visiting hipsters, and military folk-there base-nod/grinace together.) Take a coffee early Saturday morning at the Joshua Tree Coffee Company and then head to sky village Swap Meet for some treasure/curiosity hunting among the locals. Here you'll find vintage clothes- there are often real gems on offer, too, old books, and vintage homewares hawked by colorful natives. Then, grab brunch at Crossroads Cafe- everything on the menu is good, but you definitely don't want to miss out on banana bread. After, make your way to the integrator that the aforementioned alien inspired meditation space built by Ufoist George Van Tassel on what is supposedly the intersection of powerful geomagnetic forces. The unique structure supposedly boasts perfect acoustics, too, so its quartz Sonic baths are a major draw. (Please note that it is better to book tickets for them in advance.) If you are not too zenned to move after meditation, travel a short distance to The rock, which is said to be not only the largest boulder in the world, but also the initial point of contact between the good of Van Tassel and these aliens. Then head to the base to shake off before making your way up to Pappy and Harriet, a honky-tonk who has hosted legitimate musical acts such as Paul McCartney, Arctic Monkeys, Stone Age queens, and more. Don't expect to see world-famous rock stars during your visit; however, there is always a chance in this, one of the most x-preserved secrets in music. In any case, you and your best girls can indulge in barbecue and other favorite country products, and then work out your double lunches, dancing to live music and in the morning. You have two options on Sunday morning to recover from debauchery the night before: First, detox your body with green juice and a healthy fare at natural sister cafes, and the second is to go in the opposite direction with a greasy breakfast spoon at JT Country Kitchen (Anthony Bourdain was). After, work out the cookies and sauce you inevitably ordered anywhere with a hike in Joshua Tree National Park. Treks vary in terms of complexity and length, but depending on what you choose, be sure to pack enough water.
