# 2021 Fo Guang Three Acts of Goodness Young Artist Award “SDG 2 Zero Hunger” Children’s Drawing Competition

## 1. Background

The United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) 2 “Zero Hunger” aims to end hunger, achieve food security and improved nutrition and promote sustainable agriculture by 2030. The United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) designated 2021 as the International Year of Fruits and Vegetables. Through the theme “Fruits and Vegetables, Your Dietary Essentials”, it encourages eating more fruits and vegetables for health, cherishing food and reducing waste, enhancing food security, and achieving sustainable development and global prosperity.

## 2. Objectives

BLIA proposes “VEGE Plan A” as an action-based strategy to alleviate global warming, overcome the food crisis and support “Zero Hunger”. This activity responds to “VEGE Plan A” and encourages children to appreciate the benefits of vegetables and fruits, show their creativity, and express hope, concern, and gratitude for food, the environment, and the world.
