

ELLERT THOR JOHANSSON was born and raised in Reykjavik, Iceland, where he attended the University of Iceland, graduating in 1996 with a degree in Linguistics and Icelandic. After doing some post-graduate work in Iceland, he relocated to Ithaca, NY in 1998 to attend Cornell University where he taught Old Norse while pursuing graduate studies in Linguistics, receiving an MA and PhD degree in Historical linguistics, with focus on Old Germanic languages. In 2006 he was hired as a junior staff member at the Dictionary of Old Norse in Copenhagen and as an editor in 2012, where he has been involved in the digitization effort of the dictionary. He has in collaboration with the other editors of ONP written extensively about various aspects of the ONP-project and worked on promoting ONP as an important historical lexicographic resource.
