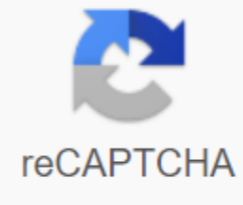

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## Free emotions flashcards pdf

There are so many ways to use a set of emotion cards with kids, at home and at school. This activity is particularly valuable as children learn to recognize and regulate their own feelings and emotions, and learn to recognize and empathize with other people's emotions. Today I'm sharing a free set of 12 print emotion cards and eight fun game suggestions you can play with them. It's great to play with preschoolers at the right time for school-age kids. Turn the top card over. Name your child's emotions and make the face to match.2. Guess Emotions Spread Out a set of cards face up. Take turns choosing a card, but don't tell the other players you choose. Make a face and see if other players can guess which card you've chosen.3 How I feel the history of the game spread a set of cards face up. Take turns choosing a card, but don't tell the other players you choose. Tell a short story about the time you felt like this, and see if other players can guess which card you chose.4 Matching Emotions Seal two sets of cards (complete with a backup template on the backside) to make your own style of concentration matching the game. To play, spread all the cards face down. Take turns turning over two cards at a time. If you find a match, you keep this pair of cards. History Emotions Lay out 3-4 cards. Using a small figurine, tell a short story about toys. For example - Peppa's balloon popped out. Ask the child to put a figurine on the map that shows how Peppa would feel if it happened.6 Positive and negative Sort a set of cards into positive and negative emotions. Discuss why each emotion is in the nominated group.7. Support Our Friend's Emotions Select Negative Emotions and talk about how to talk and support someone who we can see feels that way. Practice saying these words, playing the role of a friend who supports the emotions of others.8. Emotion Snap Print multiple copies of the cards (complete with a backup template on the back) to make your own Snap card pack - you need at least four sets. Flash card emotions are useful for teaching preschoolers to determine their feelings by using different words to express them or to help them recognize and understand other people's feelings. Learning empathy as well as self-expression in a supportive environment is very important in early childhood learning. This fun set of emotion flash cards feature emotional robots to make it more creative and entertaining. Can robots have feelings like humans? It's a funny topic to discuss. Children can use a lot of imagination about other people's feelings and their own in a more interesting way. You can come up with funny stories about each robot, for example, what might happen to them to make them feel that way. More often than not, the feelings of flash cards can be over-closed and confuse the young learner about what they are trying to convey. If the character's expression is too similar to the character before, it may not be clear what the flash card is. These sets have been designed with a boy character and girl character so that the teacher can mix and match or focus on a specific gender in their grammar. Teachers can use phrases like He's angry. or the boy is angry. This can be used to create a logical template for young students. The teacher can choose to mix the cards after practice to challenge his student's grammar knowledge. Using both packages also allows the teacher to play the fit feeling game.
