Stephen Sang has been reaching out in Yangon, Myanmar with his family. The Lord has blessed his earnest efforts with good growth.

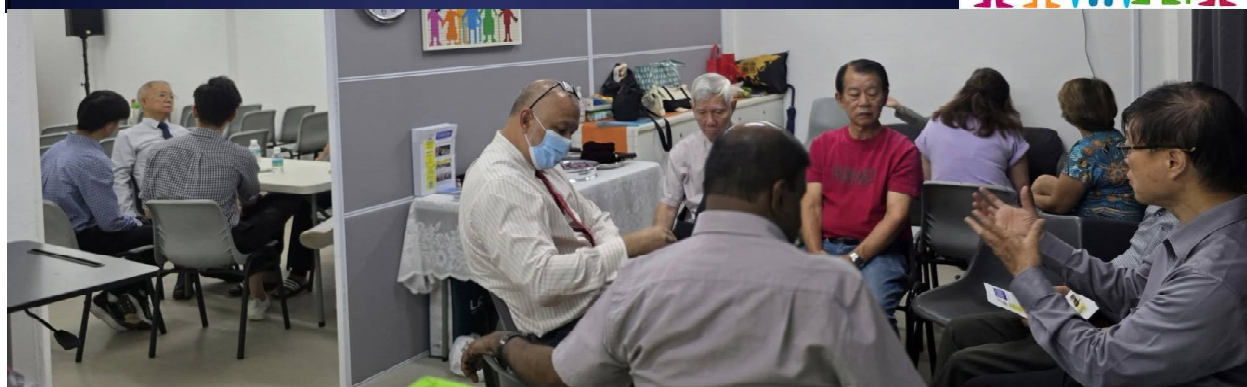
Jojo Ramos is from the Philippines has been training preachers and overseeing the Bible correspondence course.
