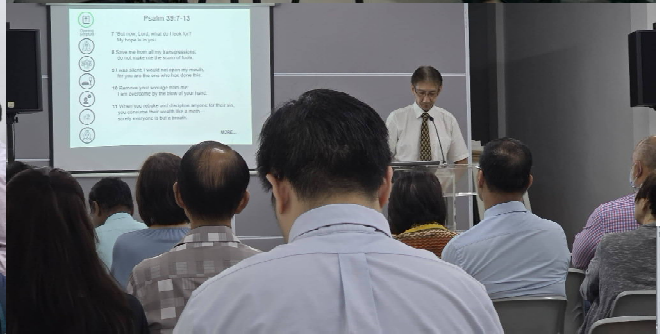

Addiction is a terrible thing

Romans 6:11-14 *Thus also consider yourselves also to be dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord. Therefore don't let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts. Neither present your members to sin as instruments of unrighteousness, but present yourselves to God, as alive from the dead, and **your members as instruments of righteousness to God.***
