The Minister of Music Minister leads and supervises the Worship and Fine Arts Ministry of Mount Pisgah Missionary Baptist Church (MPMBC). The Ministry comprises of all choirs, praise and worship team, the praise dancers, drama/theater, and handbell teams.. The position enhances the worship experience by staying abreast of relevant trends in Gospel/Christian music and integrating them into worship services. The position is part-time.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Worship Planning

- Meet weekly with the Senior Pastor to plan aspects of worship that involve all entities of the ministry.
- Assure that music and choreographed routines chosen are inspirational and in alignment with the Senior Pastor's message, theme, or sermon series.
- Remain current on trends in worship services to assure that MPMBC stays on the cutting edge.
- Secure guest artists at the request of the Senior Pastor.

Music and Band Leadership

- Promote an inter-generational worship atmosphere through selection of unique old and current worship songs.
- Partner with the Worship Leader and Praise Team to lead the congregation in worship during service.
- Develop and maintain schedules for band, choirs, praise team, theater arts participants, and praise dancers to practice and prepare for accomplished delivery of praise-filled performances.
- Stay abreast of trends in worship music and relevant artists that can be useful in supplementing the congregational worship experience.
- Accompany Senior Pastor to preaching engagements and arrange participation of band, choir, or praise team, as needed.

Drama and Dance Team Leadership

- Recruit members for the performing arts teams.
- Ensure a repertoire of varied performance styles that are appropriate for the ages and skill levels of team members.
- Manage the teaching of dance and theater arts to ensure team members' understanding of various performance styles.
- Plan a balanced program where rehearsal and instruction can be effectively accomplished within an allotted time.

Supervisory Responsibilities

- Provide clear expectations and goals for staff members and conduct regular one on one meetings to ensure that actions taken are in alignment with the annual goals of the church.
- Conduct quarterly performance reviews with staff team members.
- Encourage ministry team members' participation in Bible studies and classes that promote growth in Christ.

Qualifications Required

- Believe in Christ Jesus.
- Have a servant's heart.
- Seven (7) years of experience in music ministry at a large church (500+membership).
- Experience in leading full band contemporary worship and small group settings.
- Trained and accomplished vocalist and instrumentalist.
- Ability to recruit, train, and lead a team of volunteers in effectively and confidently achieving worship goals.
- Ability to lead in a fast-paced environment and to ensure worship is executed with excellence and minimal distractions.
- Knowledge of sound technologies.
- Willingness to learn beyond current knowledge.

Work Environment

- Work performed primarily in an office setting and requires usage of computers, calculators, printers, and other office equipment.
- Work is fast-paced, rapidly changing, stressful, and involves collaboration with other church leaders to address complex church business situations.
