 - ACTING Solo Acting SO4, SO5. Classical Monologue CM2, CM3
- Prepared to attend the final session of the Festival where they
 must perform ONE POEM and ONE ACTING SOLO. These must
 be pieces already performed in the Festival.
- The winners must be available to perform at the Festival Showcase on April 26th 2020 at Normansfield Theatre, Langdon Park, Teddington, TW11 when the cash awards will be presented.
- Previous first placed winners of the award are not elibible.
- The First prize will only be awarded if the performer reaches
 Distinction or Outstanding mark.
