



29/3/2021 Formby Village Tennis Club Reopening!

Following Government & LTA guidelines the Club will reopen from **Monday 29th March**.

The Clubhouse remains closed other than for access for the **toilets**, the **floodlight keys**, **1st aid kit** and the **carparking terminal**.

Please see separate instructions on clubhouse door and in toilet areas.

- **Before coming to the Club**

- Please remember that if any member is displaying any symptom of coronavirus (as outlined by the Government) they will be asked to leave immediately.
- Please **DO NOT** come to the Club if you are in any doubt.
- Playing tennis has the potential for increased risk of transmission of COVID-19 and therefore players play at their own risk.

Grounds and surrounding areas

- On entering the club premises, please sanitise your hands by using one of the sanitiser stations available or your own supply.
- The **15-minute buffer zone for booking** is still in operation to help avoid congestion.
- Please observe the **give way signs** where necessary and always maintain social distancing.



Court Use

- **Access to all courts** continues to be via court gate 4 for all social tennis. For **Coaching** or **Organised** sessions court gate 2 will be in use.
- Other than Organised Group Sessions all other court bookings **must** continue to be booked via the **Club Spark** site:

- When booking all **players names must** be entered on the booking form to comply with the LTA Track & Trace system.
- If a cancellation is required or a player is replaced, please make the changes to your on-line booking.
- **No Spectators** are allowed other than for supervision, 1 parent/guardian per child/vulnerable adult only.

Court Maintenance

- Please remember to take any unwanted items away with you and not left on court, there is a red bin provided for general rubbish.
- Under LTA guidelines, net winders remain removed to avoid unnecessary touching of surfaces. The net heights will be periodically checked.
- In the event of the courts flooding following heavy rain fall, **Please Do Not** use courts brushes or squishy brooms to remove excess water, this will ultimately compound the problem by removing the surface sand.

Your patience in allowing the court to clear or rescheduling court time is appreciated.
