✓ Books We Gladly Accept

- ★ Gently used or new children's picture books (ages 0-8)
- ★ Early readers and short chapter books
- ★ Board books for babies and toddlers
- ★ First Nations stories – by Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander authors or authentic representation
- ★ Inclusive stories – celebrating diverse families and identities
- ★ Non-fiction for kids – animals, art, science, or nature
- ★ Clean and complete – no scribbles, tears, or missing pages



Think; books that make a child smile, imagine, or feel proud of who they are.

⊘ Books We Cannot Accept

- Books that are ripped, stained, mouldy, or incomplete
- Scribbled or heavily worn books
- Adult fiction or non-fiction (unless for parents)
- Religious texts promoting one belief system
- Secondary school textbooks
- Old textbooks, encyclopedias, or workbooks
- Magazines or adult comics
