Wayne Wyten is a graduate of Bradley University and received his doctorate in social psychology from the University of Illinois, Chicago in 1981. He has taught at DuPage College and Santa Clara University, and currently teaches at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas. He received outstanding teaching awards in the second division of the American Psychological Association (APA) and at DuPage College. He is a member of Division 1, 2 and 8 of the American Psychological Association and a member of the Midwest Psychological Association. In 1991, he helped chair the APA National Conference to improve the quality of psychology education for students. He is a former president of the Society for the Teaching of Psychology and the Rocky Mountain Psychological Association. In 2006, one of the five national teaching awards awarded annually by the Society for the Teaching of Psychology was named after him. Wyten conducted research on a wide range of subjects, including measuring education, jury decision-making, attribution theory, pressure as a form of stress, and textbook technology. He is also the author of PSYCHOLOGY: THEMES and VARIATIONS (Cengage, 2017, 10th edition). Wyten created an educational CD-ROM called PSYKTREK: MULTIMEDIA INTRODUCTION TO PSYCHOLOGY and co-authored a chapter on introductory psychology course for OXFORD HANDBOOK OF UNDERGRADUATE PSYCHOLOGY EDUCATION (Weiten and Houska, 2015). Doug McCann holds a bachelor's degree from the University of Waterloo and a Doctorate from the University of Western Ontario. After completing his PhD, he received his doctorate from Ohio State University. Since 1983 he has been a member of the Faculty of Psychology at York University. He has taught at the graduate level in clinical, development and social/personal programs and at the undergraduate level his current teaching interests focus on introductory psychology, social psychology and the psychology of depression. He received various teaching awards while at York University and served in several administrative positions at York University, most recently as Director of the Higher Psychology Program at York University. His research interests focus on social cognition, I, and models of processing information of depression.
