When my OCD kicks in renaming mp3 ID tags etc I get a lot of dead tracks. A simple solution... Make a clever playlist called All Files with This Rule: Artist Not 123456789? (or any meaningless name that won't be in your library). Make a static playlist called All Live Files. Make a smart playlist called Missing Files with these rules: Match all the following rules, playlist All files, playlist not all live files. Select all files from All Files and drag them to All Live Files. Dead files marked (!) won't copy any more. The missing files will contain all your dead files. Select everything and delete it with Shift-Delete (or Option-Delete on Mac). Vuala, a good clean iTunes library. (via Paul Mayne) Selected all the tracks in my Missing Files folder, made the Files a new playlist of the pick (since it won't allow you to drag and drop dead tracks into the playlist) and then delete them from there. As for Google, it seems that the company is not too happy that Gmail for Android 4.2 has been leaked and it is already available in the wild. In fact, it appears the search giant has asked Android Police, an online publication that put up Gmail 4.2 download links in the first place to remove them. The company also announced that the winners will be contacted soon regarding their prizes. Under each winner, the company placed the wallpaper they created. Users can click on any of the wallpapers to view them in their native 3168x1440 resolutions. Of course, the use of these wallpapers is not limited to only OnePlus devices, although many of the images have a logo or never Settle slogan that may look somewhat out of place on a device not OnePlus. For those who want to download all the wallpaper at once, XDA developers have published a handy file with the whole lot. Tagged: Samsung's OnePlusWallpapers have reportedly agreed to cut its Android Settings and give Google's media offerings a central focus on their devices as part of a sweeping agreement between the two giants. By Re/Code's Liz Gunnes and Ina Freed, Google and Samsung began discussing the agreement back at CES, after the launch of the Galaxy NotePRO and Galaxy TabPRO tablets, downloaded by UX magazine, a tile-based home-screen replacement. Google execs have reportedly dismayed about how radically Samsung has moved away from Google's vision of Android with the magazine UX. Check out the UX log in our hands-on from CES. The differences between it and the user interface of Android shares are obvious: Citing several sources familiar with the company's thinking, the report said that Google persuaded Samsung to consider dumping or changing the interface of UX magazine for upcoming devices. It is not yet known that Google had to give in in order for the Korean company to adopt such a radical change of strategy. Update: The concession is likely offloading Motorola.While the details of the pact are fuzzy at the moment, its magnitude is reportedly important. One Re/code source calls it a huge change, a sea change. A huge change in the sea not only did Samsung abandon the promotion of UX magazine, but the company also said it was culling some of its own media centers and apps in favor of Google services. In other words, instead of duplicating Google's offerings, Samsung cover Google's apps and them in the spotlight on their upcoming phones. This is another change that cannot be overstated - Samsung has long been working to give users alternatives to virtually every major Google app, from app store to media apps such as S Voice and S Translate. While many users simply ignored them, Samsung insisted on stuffing their devices with these apps, which many industry watchers perceived as a way of hedging bets against a possible turnaround from Google. Ars Technica's Ron Amadeo stressed the length Samsung went to do so in a piece last year that included this infographic: Google, in turn, had reason to fear Samsung, which controls most of the Android ecosystem, to the point that users are more familiar with the Galaxy brand than with Android.Now mutual apprehension seems to have been put aside. So what has changed? It's hard to know for sure, but this report, along with a broad patent deal announced earlier this week, suggests that the two companies will get closer than ever. The world's largest Internet company and the world's largest consumer electronics company have joined forces in the long term, and the fruits of this alliance will shape the world for at least the next decade. Decades.
