Q: C# WCF ChannelException is not populating ChannelErrorCodes I am trying to consume a WCF service on a separate server (a .NET 4.0 app running on Windows Server 2008 R2) from a client on the same server (also running on Windows Server 2008 R2). Both the client and the server are .NET 4.0 projects. I can successfully make a connection and call the methods of the service. However, if one of those methods throws a ChannelException, the inner exception object is never populated.
