Later renamed the Missions Ministry under the leadership of Pastor Mitchell, the Missions Ministry's purpose is to fulfill the Great Commission (Matthew 28:16-20); to reach all people, spread the goodness of God, and glorify Him.

With the support of our church family, we engage in several projects to care for our local and global communities. Past projects include donation of food, clothing and hygiene items to those in need, visiting the elderly in nursing homes, showing support to sick and shut-in and bereaved families, and more.

We support foreign missions in partnership with Lott Carey, a global Christian missional community that extends the Christian witness around the world by coming alongside indigenous communities and supporting ministries of evangelism, compassion, empowerment, and advocacy through prayer partnerships, financial support, and technical assistance. The Missions Ministry also partners with the Tuckahoe Baptist Association, the Baptist General Association of VA and the Baptist General Association.
