Tempered is very strong and is created by heating the glass to an extremely high temperature and then cooling very quickly. This creates a very strong glass. It is known for being used on the side of cars and rear windows, as well as home use such as shower doors, coffee pots and glass doors on ovens. The second type of safety glass is laminated glass. This type has three layers. The outer layers are conventional glass, but the middle layer is a thin core made of vinyl board, which is connected by heat with two other glass layers. This is the kind you'll find in the windshield of a car. Tempered glass uses extremely high heat to curing the glass, but what happens is that the core of the glass, the inner layer, becomes compressed much faster than the outer layers. This happens over and over again during the tempering process, and ultra fine series of stress lines develop. They are not visible to the naked eye, but break the glass, and it breaks along these many and small stress lines into small, safer pieces. These pieces are quite uniform in size, and the edges are smooth. Laminated glass allows the two outer layers of glass to crack, but the inner vinyl layer holds all the pieces together. This vinyl layer remains intact and broken glass remains glued to the vinyl layer. In fact, in accidents where the windshield is broken, many times it can actually be peeled off the window intact. The pieces hold and leave as one piece. Even in heavy accidents, this laminated glass could break into large pieces, but it will not break into small or jagged, dangerous pieces.
