For a special chapter of the manga, see Chapter 0. One Piece Film: Strong World is the 10th film in the One Piece series. It was written by the manga creator Eiichiro Oda. The film's director Muehisa Sakai. News of the film first appeared during the screening of The Chopper Plus episode, during which the teaser of the tenth film was shown. The film was originally intended for spring release in 2009, but complications with the script pushed back the release date. The film finally premiered on December 12, 2009. On July 28, 2012, FUNimation announced that they had purchased a license for One Piece Film: Strong World and have since announced a release date of November 19. As mentioned, the film is an original story written by Eiichiro Oda himself in honor of the tenth anniversary of One Piece. In previous films, Oda only supplied character designs and approved story ideas. For one movie piece: Strong World. Toei personally asked if he would write the script. The film is set between the Thriller Bark arch and the Sabaoody Archipelago arch, as Brooke is shown along with the other Straw Hat Pirates (making it his first appearance in the movie), and Sengoku and Garp are still in their positions in the Marine Corps. As a promotion for the film, the first 1.5 million Japanese moviegoers who went to see One Piece Film: Strong World, received volume 0 manga. The bonus gift of 0th Volume depicts the world of One Piece 20 years ago, and is directly related to the film, in particular, it depicts the war between Pirate King Gol D. Roger and the legendary pirate Golden Lion Shiki. Synopsis Edit East Blue in Crisis? News hits The Straw Hat Pirates on their way. The story begins at the headquarters of the Marine Corps, where Vice Admiral Garp and Navy Admiral Sengoku witness the ship Shiki floating in the sky overhead. Shiki uses force to lift all the ships into the sky and then drops them before leaving, claiming it is a warning. Next, Luffy is seen now on the island in the sky, and chasing a crocodile like a monster. This monster is overcome by others, who, in turn, fights several more times, while Luffy watches until he finally briefly battles and defeats the final winner, the bear-like creature, with Gear Third. It turned out that the various members of the Straw Hat are divided around the floating island of Sanji with Usopp, Soro and Chopper, and finally, robin, Frankie, and Brooke together, who all encounter similar monstrous animals. Us, meanwhile, swimming in a large pool is shown for the first time. Shiki and his henchmen enter, where it is revealed that she was taken to this place against her will, and the scene erupts a week earlier. Together, two ships go to a floating island, which has seen before, where Shiki suddenly kidnaps Nami. The rest try to save her, but by controlling the Thousand Solar, using his power, he runs away from them, and also scatters them among the fragments of the island. Back in the present, Shiki asks Nami to become his navigator, but she refuses. Dr. Indigo appears with a developed bird named Billy, who can use electricity by showing him shiki, but after being shocked by it, Shiki throws it aside. They learn there that Shiki plans to release the animals on an island in the East Blue in a gambit to force the surrender of the World Government. They also learn that to prove the power of animals, he plans a demonstration using a village on a floating island. Luffy and Nami join others in the village, and they also learn about the plan from the villagers, who, not knowing where the Straw Hats come from, are relieved to get rid of the monsters. Shiki confronts the Straw Hats. Nami is seen by the camera den den Mushi, and Shiki decides to personally pick her up over his head. He arrives after a while and confronts the Straw Hats that are there. Despite some initial successes in fending it off, the Straw Hats are defeated, and Nami is forced to return Shiki to the ground, agreeing to leave them, and her hometown will be. Usopp, the only surviving crew member tries to stop her, but Shiki knocks him out. We record the message using Tone Dial., which should be a farewell message. Later, he revealed Straw Hats managed to evade the Marines and continue their adventure. Luffy confronts Nami over a message she left on Dial's tone, angry that she didn't believe in them. When others revealed that he had not heard the entire message, Nami tried to stop Luffy from playing, feeling embarrassed by his content. Previous film One Piece, Episode Chopper Plus: Blossoming winter, Miracle Sakura, earned only 920 million yen (\$11 million) in its entire run, less than the 10th film earned in just two days. One Piece Film: Strong World has opened on 188 screens across Japan. 103 of these screens had sold-out screenings over the weekend. The on-screen film averaged 5.52 million yen (US\$62,200) - a record for a nationwide release in Japan. The first day, the film received 553 million yen (\$6.24 million), and on the second day it was 485 million yen (\$5.47 million). In total, the film has been seen 820,000 times. One of the reasons for the huge audience was the manga One Piece Volume 0, which was given to the first participants. Toei decided to add another print of 1 million copies for the manga. Unlike previous One Piece films, Oda personally oversaw the production of the new film. The promotion of this film led to a significant increase in sold volumes: All 56 volumes of manga that were published before the release of the film in the top 200 Oricon sales charts in the week of December 7 to 13, 2009. Shueisha had already announced before the premiere of the movie that volume 56 was published with 2.85 million copies in its first print. One Piece Film: Strong World was officially selected for the 50th Annecy International Animated Film Festival in June 2010. This was announced in the cover of Jump Chapter 587. The One Piece Film: Strong World DVD/BD version had new scenes added at the request of Oda, showing Billy, Yuo and other animals and people of the fate of Merway Island. Shanks and Whitebeard appeared in the early trailer the film speaks of Shiki. This was a reference to the fact that Oda originally wanted to mention Shiki in the storyline during their meeting. However, in the final version they appear in the final song with Ace. In the film, Robin's eyes have their original brown color, unlike her blue eyes in the anime and other films.
