Fine Wines

Tenuta San Guido Guidalberta £153
Toscana, Italy.

Today, the narrative of Tenuta San Guido's wines is based on different expressions of the same territory, including the world famous Sassicaia, from which it all began, and Guidalberto, which after a genesis of over twenty five years. Grapes are carefully selected by hand using a sorting table. Gentle pressing and destemming of the bunches is carried out to prevent the grapes from breaking and excessive release of tannins finishing with fermentation in stainless steel tanks to produce a truly elegant wine of raspberry and cherry palate with expertly balanced tannins.

Stella Bella Suckfizzle Sauvignon Blanc Semillon £90
Margaret River, Australia.

From its boutique winery in the heart of Margaret River, surrounded by the Southern and Indian Oceans, each small batch is hand-picked, then transferred to oak barrel for 10 months. Fresh gooseberry, pear, jasmine flowers and lime blossom on the nose with fresh and crisp with hints of guava, pear and tropical fruits on the palate.

Alan Gautheron Chablis 1er Cru 'Mont Milieu' £113
Chablis, France

Domaine Gautheron been in the family for seven generations with Chablis from the 1er Cru vineyards, 'Mont de Milieu' being cold fermented to capture the purity of fruit. Maturation in tanks and avoiding any barrel ageing, preserves the fresh steely flavours and unique influence of the chalky vineyard soils. It has powerful floral aromas and notes of peaches, apricots and white flower. The palate continues to be expressive with delightful flavours and yet is crisp and dry, with an elegant minerality.

Mary Morey Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru 'Les Vergers'. £300
Burgundy

The Marc Morey estate is now run by daughter Marie-Josèphe and her husband with their daughter Sabine. The 9ha estate is one of Chassagne Montrachet's most important and influential, wine from the 1er Cru 'Les Vergers' vineyard carry the aroma of honey, acacia flowers and almond, on the palate, the intensity of the fruit is matched by the wine's subtle acidity and the roundness of bottle maturity.

Fine Wines

Geoff Merrill Aged Reserve Shiraz £96
Adelaide, Australia

Geoff Merrill was born in 1953 and the family moved to the Barossa Valley, just north of Adelaide when he was 11. The limited reserve range of wines from the Merrill stable are the result of Geoff's desire to make and release small batches of his finest wines.. Full of spice and intense, medium bodied in style with concentrated black fruit flavours with chocolate - an example of Australian Shiraz at its finest.

By Clinet – Pomerol £120
France

Saint-Émilion and Pomerol sit next to each other on the right bank of Bordeaux. Pomerol boasting the famous names of Petrus and Le Pin. By Clinet Pomerol was created to artfully blend the three different types of terroir. Made from Merlot with 5% Cabernet Franc and aged in barrel for 12 months. It is deep garnet in colour, with aromas of fruits from the forest such as blackcurrant and plum with a touch of oriental spice, black pepper. The soft, creamy texture on the palate brings ripe fruit, mixed herbs, leather and chocolate

Chateau Musar Gaston Hochar £130
Bekaa Valley, Lebanon

The Bekaa is a fertile valley in Lebanon. Chateau Musar was created in 1930 and is renowned for red wines of complexity and maturity, having been aged in oak for up to 15 months, and then aged in bottle for 4 years. They are a blend of Cabernet, Cinsault and Carignan, they are blended to produce a Bordeaux style red but with a Mediterranean typicity. Red cherries, plums and figs dominate the nose with a hint of eastern spice. Kirsch and plums follow through to the palate with blackcurrant and chocolate. The tannins are velvety soft and this wine has a lot of depth and fruit concentration with a long finish.

Rivetto Barolo 'Serralunga', Piemonte £180
Italy

Serralunga is one of the most famous vineyard sites of Barolo, where the Nebbiolo vines enjoy perfect south east facing exposure on chalky soils. This intense, full bodied red has a wonderful scent of violets and roses. It is harmoniously balanced, rich with flavour held by firm tannins, powerful yet never aggressive. The palate captures the tipicity of the site with mineral, herb and subtle oak character.
